Cold temperatures have had a negative impact on the number of golf days; however the maintenance team at Wildwood has remained productive. We have added over 30 tons of sand to bunkers. Once conditions have thawed we will continue to monitor bunker depths and add sand as needed. Several trees that have not survived the past few seasons are being removed along with trimming overgrown limbs. This has a positive impact on turf by allowing more air flow and sunlight to reach the turf canopy. An electric valve has been installed on the driving range tee. This replaces the manual valve and now gives us the opportunity to water evenings and early mornings without disrupting practice and warm up times. The pump station is the heart of the irrigation system and without it working properly we would not be able to implement a solid agronomic plan. Our annual pump station service will also take place in the coming month. This service is considered an insurance policy to hopefully avoid a serious breakdown during the summer when water is at its highest demand. February can typically be one of our colder months so I would like to revisit frost delays. Now that ground temperatures have fallen frost delays will be more common thru February and into first week of March. Did you know that simply walking on frosted greens can damage the turf? The time for recovery cannot be determined. When there is a delay updates are made hourly so be sure to check in with the pro-shop for the latest update. The new Game Improvement Center will feature practice training aids that we use every day in our Academy classes. We want to share these with you to use as you practice on the range. There will be a golf bag and display of various training aids on the range daily for you to use as you practice. Alignment guides, grip guides, putting aids, impact bag, clubface orientation guides, swing speed sticks, plus other basic items that will enhance your practice. A free standing mirror will also be available for use and will be mobile enough to move to where you are practicing. Use them and return them to the display area. If you have a question, ask any of us how something works. We will spend some time initially showing you how these aids can be used most effectively as we have time between appointments. It is our mission to help you enjoy your golf game and your time at Wildwood Green!

The Golf Academy at Wildwood Green Launches Long Term Junior Academy

Families,

We are very excited about introducing the long term junior academy to our programming this year. We are dedicated to always improving our programs across the board and especially for our juniors. When we find something that we think will enhance and advance our juniors faster, we take action.

Starting this year we will be launching The Golf Academy at Wildwood Green Junior Academy! The Academy is structured using the Operation 36 Junior Development Platform. This platform is being used across the region and the country and consists of coaches, parents, and juniors all working towards the goal of shooting 36 or better for 9 holes!

Each junior that enrolls in the Academy will be issued an Op 36 Bag Tag and be set up in a profile in our Op 36 Academy Mobile App. The Op 36 Platform consists of 6 levels, and has a 12 subject curriculum that the coach will deliver throughout the Academy semesters. When the junior can demonstrate objectives learned to the coach, they will earn badges on their bag tag, and will be able to track and log their progress in the mobile app. Each achievement is tracked in a social activity feed and points are earned for completing objectives, as well as playing/practicing outside of class. To graduate from the Academy the junior must progress through all six levels and ultimately shoot 36 or better for 9 holes from their full tee box.

We will be hosting a Parent Orientation on February 21 at 3pm to go over more details, and will begin registration on February 28. Spots will be limited to 5 per class to maintain a 5-1 student/coach ratio. Be sure to register with me and attend the orientation to ensure your junior has a spot for the Spring Semester. The Semester will start in April and run through June. We will take a summer break in July and start the Fall Semester in August through October. We are looking forward to a great season!



Rule of Month

There recently have been changes to the USGA Golf Rules with a launch of the 2016 Rule Book

Rule: Withdrawal of Rule on Ball Moving After Address - Rule 18-2b (Ball Moving after Address) has been withdrawn.

Relief: This means that if a ball at rest moves after the player addresses it, the player is no longer automatically deemed to have caused the ball to move. A one-stroke penalty under Rule 18-2 will be applied only when the facts show that the player has caused the ball to move.

Scenario on Hole #12 at Wildwood Green: Your ball has stopped on the green of Hole #12. You then step up and address your golf ball to putt. If you do not hit the ball with your putter and an outside source such as the wind causes your ball to move, you will not receive a penalty stroke. Unfortunately, if you do accidentally hit your golf ball with your putter that does count as a stroke.
