We are lining up all of the work for the greens conversion. Some tree work should start, weather permitting, in February. Our plan is to start the practice green areas as early as possible so we can have all three open by the time we start the greens on the course. We will keep you updated monthly. We hope everyone enjoyed the Members Christmas party (our staff had another outstanding performance) and enjoyed a happy time with their families over the holidays. Again thank you for participating in the greens renovation and being a member!

With the greens conversion approved for July, the maintenance team will begin prepping for the project in January. Several projects are planned in the coming months beginning with over 80 trees being removed. Tree removal is expected to last up to 8 weeks with the consideration of inclement weather that winter months often experience. Once tree removal has been completed we will begin renovation of the putting green complex and will add a small putting green behind the range tee. We expect to open these areas by the first of July and begin greens conversion shortly after. I normally announce our aerification schedule for greens in this newsletter. This schedule has changed drastically with the upcoming greens conversion. There will be no core aerification this spring including heavy topdressings. We will however implement small solid tine aerifications along with light topdressings to ensure a quality putting surface right up to our scheduled greens conversion. A pre-emergent herbicide will be applied late February early March for summer annual weeds such as crabgrass. A post emergent herbicide will be incorporated at this time to clean up any winter annual weeds that may have broken through our fall programs. Other areas of focus during these next two months will be sand traps, outer edges and a few irrigation repairs. I would like to thank everyone for the positive comments and encourage all of you to fill out comment cards. This is an excellent way for us to hear your comments and continue to get better. Dear Members,

2016 was a tough year all around and I am sure you are excited to start the New Year just like I am. With that said, the staff and I all wish you a very happy and prosperous 2017!

This next year will be exceptionally exciting one as we will be getting brand new Champion Ultra Dwarf Bermuda Grass greens in late September or early October. I again want to thank everyone who has helped make this a reality. All of the champion club members who have committed to helping fund the conversion really came through when we needed you and it was great to see everyone rally behind the program and make the new greens a possibility. We definitely could not have done it without you!

As of now, we have some an estimated timeline for the conversion:

In early to mid-February we will begin to remove trees around the course starting near the clubhouse and putting green. We have 81 trees to remove as of now.

In early to mid-March we plan to begin construction on the putting green and chipping areas behind the clubhouse and at the driving range. We will look to reopen the new practice areas in mid-July when we close the course down.

In mid-July we will begin the work on the course...fumigating the greens, laying the new sprigs and growing in the Bermuda grass. We hope to reopen at the tail end of September or early October. (Next Slide Continues Article)

As a reminder on frost delay procedures: We will give golfers 45 minutes notice before beginning play for the day after a frost delay has occurred. Please check the club's facebook page and automated voice mail frequently for updates. You can check the voice mail by dialing 919-846-8376 extension 1 and you can keep current through facebook by becoming our friend. Just search for Wildwood Green Golf Club.

On January 7th we will begin our winter weekend shotgun starts. All play on Saturdays and Sundays will begin at 10:00 AM (unless there is a frost delay). These shotgun starts will remain in place through the end of February or early March depending on the forecasted weather and time change. You may book a tee time in these shotguns just like a normal day...booking two weeks ahead of time. We will begin a waiting list as needed and days that are forecasted to have nicer weather will surely fill up fast. Please be sure to book early and cancel any unneeded spots during these times.

As a reminder, we ask that you always call the golf shop if you cannot make your tee time. No shows have become a problem here again recently and without you letting us know that you cannot make your time, our other members and guests are not able to get on the course. Anytime you need to cancel a tee time please call the golf shop at 919-846-8376 extension 2. If no one is available when you call, be sure to leave a message and we will be sure to return your call as needed.

It's that time of year again when the temperatures overnight get below the freezing mark. Many golfers have never been properly educated on why golf course superintendents have frost delays. The golf course is a large piece of property and normally uses a different type of grass than what is growing on our own front lawn. We need to remember that even though we might not see frost on our own lawn in the morning, it does not mean it isn't out on the golf course.

The second thing we need to remember in regards to frost delays is that damage to the putting surface can occur if golfers were allowed to walk on the greens. The following article comes directly from the Golf Course Superintendents Association of America. "Frost is basically frozen dew that has crystallized on the grass, making it hard and brittle. Walking on frost-covered greens causes the plant to break and cell walls to rupture, thereby losing its ability to function normally. When the membrane is broken, much like an egg, it cannot be put back together.

Golfers who ignore frost delays will not see immediate damage. The proof generally comes 48-72 hours later as the plant leaves turn brown and die. The result is a thinning of the putting surface and a weakening of the plant. The greens in turn become more susceptible to disease and weeds. While it may not appear to be much of an issue if a foursome begins play early on frost covered greens, consider the number of footprints that may occur on any given hole by one person is approximately 60. Multiply that by 18 holes with an average of 200 rounds per day and the result is 216,000 footprints on greens in a day or 6,480,000 in a month." Remember, the Staff at Wildwood Green is doing everything they possibly can to get golfers on the course as quickly as possible while still protecting the turf. To help the Wildwood Green Staff, we ask that you call 919-846-8376 Ext. 1 to receive course updates when there is a possibility of a Frost Delay. If you should have any questions, please let one of the Golf Shop Professional Staff know.
