



Rule of Month

Rule: #24 – 2 Immovable Obstructions

Interference by an immovable man-made obstruction occurs when a ball lies in or on the obstruction or when the obstruction interferes with the player's stance or the area of his intended swing.

Relief: Except when the ball is in a water hazard or a lateral hazard a player may take relief from interference by an immovable man-made obstruction. If the ball lies through the green, the player must lift the ball and drop it, without penalty within one club-length of and not nearer the hole than the nearest point of relief. The nearest point of relief may not be in a hazard or on a putting green.

Relation to Hole #2 and #4 at Wildwood Green: Some examples of immovable obstructions would be the steps on #4 that go up to the green and the railroad ties that lie along the cart path on #2. If your ball lies on the steps on Hole #4 or lies up against the wood of the stairs which would interfere with your swing you may take free relief. You may take relief of one club length, no closer to the hole and you may NOT take that relief by dropping your ball onto the putting green.
