2018 has proved to be the wettest year we have had since rainfall totals have been recorded. That works well during the hot summer when turf is growing but not so good during the dormant winter. With the turf in a dormant non growing period controlling cart traffic becomes a focus. We are currently in a period where we have been cart path only for several days. High traffic areas become even more wore out during the winter months. Carts that don't obey rules can leave unsightly marks on fairways that will not recover until early summer.

The maintenance team makes every attempt to have the 90 degree rule in affect. We will start roping areas off over the next few weeks and leave in place until the growing season. Tree removal is also ongoing. As you can imagine weather conditions have slowed this project. Once we have dried out this project will continue. #### Tips from the Pro:

Improving your putting can lower your scores more significantly than any other part of your game. Here is my best tip to sinking more putts!

**Speed:** Getting the speed to match the distance is the most important part of putting. Drop three balls on the green and make a stroke taking the putter back in line with your back foot. If you make your stroke the same speed, all three putts will travel the same distance. Now pace that distance off to gauge how far that stroke makes the ball travel.

Distance: Do this again with a stroke that goes back two inches further than your original stroke and these putts should go further than the original three. You have now established two "gears," one for short putts and another for mid-range putts. You can add more "gears" by adding more length to each stroke.

**Practice:** Hit five putts to each of your "gears." Start short to long and make five in a row within one foot of each other. If you mess up, start over! Do this drill over and over until you can do it without messing up.

Get your speed right and you will eliminate three-putts, make more birdies and lower your scores!

The junior Winter Skills Classes are now forming. The classes for middle and high school age juniors are geared towards preparation for playing on school teams this spring.
