

#### <u>Rules Question of Month</u>

#### Are you the king of the rules? Try to answer the rules question to this scenario.

Rule: 13-4 Ball in Hazard

**Scenario:** A player hits from a bunker and his ball comes to rest out of bounds or is lost. Since the player has to drop a ball back in play, does he:

- A) Hand place a ball in the bunker on the best area in the sand.
- B) Drop a ball in the bunker without testing, smoothing or raking the sand.
- C) Rake or smooth the sand and then drop his ball into the bunker.
- D) Drop a ball up near the line where the original ball went out of bounds.





Answer to the Question of Month

C) Rake or smooth the sand and then drop his ball into the bunker.



The prohibitions in Rule 13-4 apply only when the player's ball is in the hazard or when it has been lifted from a hazard. Furthermore, exception 2 under 13-4 allows a player, after playing his ball out of a hazard, to smooth sand or soil in the hazard without restriction even if the player will be playing out of the hazard again because of a lost or out of bounds ball. This right overrides any conflicting provisions in other Rules, including Rule 13-2.
