WILDWOOD GREEN GOLF CLUB June 2018

Roger Watson - Owner

I have had the pleasure of working closely with the Wildwood Green staff over the last few months to establish a plan to improve our facilities and services. This plan includes increasing membership benefits and value. A sincere thank you goes out to the staff, board of advisors, and the Champion Club members that strongly support our efforts. We have improved the greens (after the harsh winter damage) and currently have finished most of the greens problem areas. We will be removing a few more trees next winter to help prevent future shade issues and we have plans to double tarp some greens that remain in the shade longer, keeping them warmer. Other weak Bermuda grass areas are being addressed and most of those will be improved by July. Two forward tee boxes on holes #3 and #12 have been sodded with a more shade tolerant zoysia grass. Other areas, such as #2 white tee, #2 fairway, and the range tees will be sodded as needed before July 1st.

Cart path bumps have been ground down to improve the ride and some additional paving will be completed where the creek pipe crossings have been replaced. We have some new equipment to assist Rick Durham and the maintenance team with the daily maintenance of the entire course and we are planning to purchase a root pruner to keep on hand to prune roots along the cart paths. This will help prevent some of the root invasion. The irrigation pumps and pump house have been updated and Rick is expanding automatic irrigation to tees. Cleaning up and improving the aesthetics around the grounds and course is ongoing and we have an additional person assigned to that area for the season. We have a new business manager, Elaina Cole, whose first assignment has been working on improving the food and beverage operation. We will have a number of improved menu items that will include a featured sandwich and cocktail called a transfusion (created with vodka, lemon-lime soda, club soda, and a splash of grape juice with a lime garnish). We ask that you complete comment cards during your round and during your visits to the course…we would like to know how we are doing from your perspective!

Our golf staff is led by our general manager, Jeff Engelhaupt, and is set for the season. Dan Alton, Joe Martin, Jude Aschenbrenner, and Mindy Glatfelter are the nucleus of a great golf shop team. They are eager to make your hours at the club fun and worry free. You have an outstanding program of organized events that include golf events, poker nights, beer and burger evenings, couples golf, member-member, half price guest days, and our 50/50 raffle. In the 50/50 we have already given out over \$2500 in prize money! We strive to improve the value of your membership everyday and look forward to many fun years ahead.

Our current \$1,000,000 membership drive has not reached our goal of going private, even with an extension of the \$0 initiation fee. Effective June 1st initiation fees will be required for new members. We hope you were able to take advantage of the membership incentives and sign a new member under this drive. If so, you will receive a free month of member dues in 2019. For those of you who recently joined or sponsored a new member under this drive, you are eligible for a chance to win some prizes which include two shots at making a hole-in-one that would be worth \$1,000,000! We will have the details of the social day coming out soon and we are currently targeting mid-July for the event date.

We ask that you please respect the driving range rules and only hit balls from the correct stations! We have recently changed our range activity and require drivers and woods from the first four stations, closest to the clubhouse. Please, at no time, remove any of the rubber tees that are in the first four stations or turn the mats at the last four stations. No shows for tee times have become a real problem and we need your help. Call us to make cancellations and adjustments. We are trying hard to continue keeping your dues affordable!

All of these improvements do not come without the necessary funds. Effective July 1st we will have a 6% monthly dues increase to help support and continue all of these improvements.

In closing, we will again offer a prepayment program during the month of August that will save you either a month of free dues or a 10% discount off of the annual dues if paid in advance during the month of August. Jeff will send out the details as we near the middle of July. Thank you for being a member!

<u>Rick Durham – Superintendent</u>

With the recent rains and warmer weather, the golf course is beginning to blossom. Greens are beginning to recover and are improving daily. Monday, June 4th, we will start our maintenance program. This time will allow us to complete many different cultural practices that will aide in improving our putting surfaces. Top dressing or sanding is one example of the type of cultural practice that will be completed. By applying sand we can improve smoothness, speed and create a firmer surface. Greens will not be our only focus for the month. Fairway and tee aerification will be conducted throughout the month. This process will be completed with an Aerway that will have minimal disruption. Aerification reduces compaction and allows water and air into the soil profile. This process is beneficial to root growth and the overall strength of the plant. Fertilizer applications will also be made at this time. Other items will include cleaning pond edges, sand trap and irrigation improvement. Dear Members.

The golf course is green! The warm weather and recent rains have really brought our bermuda grass out from winter's dormancy. Rick and the maintenance team have been busy taking care of the few issues we have remaining around the course. With the severe winter weather we figured out pretty quickly where the trouble spots will be. Rick has devised a plan for this coming winter to keep these areas warmer, helping lead to fewer issues. Elaina has done a great job bringing the grille up to speed and getting new staff in place for the summer. She has also brought on some delicious menu items and a couple of new drinks to try out. Please stop by and see for yourself!

No shows and late cancellations have become an increasing issue with us here at Wildwood. Both members and non-members are at fault. We are trying to keep you dues affordable and by having the number of no-shows or late cancellations that we did during the month of May, we lost close to \$15,000 (if not more) in potential revenue. Imagine what we could do around the facility with that revenue!!! You must understand dues are affordable because the amount of play we receive and the number of members we have. By not allowing us to fill unused tee times, you are hindering the operation's potential. Please, please, please, please cancel your unused times as far ahead as possible. This will help us avoid having to charge you for tee times (and unused tee times) prior to your play on the day of.

Thank you for your dedication to the club and thank you for helping bring in new members! Many of you will receive 1 and 2 months free member dues during 2019 for doing so and you have helped us move in a great way towards becoming fully private!!

With everyone being built differently, not all players can swing the same way. Some players will swing upright, others flat and others may have a loop showing two planes. The reality here is that none of that matters. What does matter however, is how the golf club should travel through impact and how your body works conducive to that to produce that swing. There are **two** major components. **#1 is how the club moves through impact**. **#2 is how the body works to produce #1**. Without both of these components working together properly, you will not make consistent contact with the ball. Unfortunately, most of us have formed some bad habits over time which impede our ability to create a proper and natural move. These bad habits came from bad advice such as "keep your head down" or "release the club at impact" to name a couple. These unnatural movements have muscle memory on their side and they need to be broken down and made natural again. Learning how the club is supposed to travel through impact is the easy part. Learning how the body is supposed to work through the swing can be challenging but fortunately, since the way the body is supposed to work is fundamentally natural - our body will conform just like when we learned to walk, swim or ride a bike.

The weekly pairings will be created by the Golf Shop and different games will be played from week to week. The MGA is open to active members with an established USGA handicap.

A total points calculation will be kept throughout the year and based on the following:
