Champion Club Program

After hearing back from over 200 members we have decided to pursue the conversion to bermuda grass greens. We have 2, 3, 5 and 10 year pricing options to help us convert our greens from the current bent grass to bermuda grass. Please fill out a commitment form if you haven't already. Please contact the golf shop if you have any questions. (Breakdown of 24 and 36 month options are on the next page)

A few things to remember:

- ✓ This is NOT an assessment. It is an option to prepay your dues or to lock in a reduced dues rate for yourself
- \checkmark This is NOT a mandatory program and can only be opted in by you, the individual member
- ✓ Champion club benefits extend for the length of your membership
- ✓ The conversion could begin as early as May 15th or as late as July 15th
- ✓ We hope to redesign the putting green and chipping areas as well as add a small putting green behind the driving range
- ✓ If ownership changes, provision can be made to honor the term agreement put in place by you opting in

Champion Club Benefits:

- ✓ Dues are frozen for 2, 3, 5 or 10 years depending on your selected plan.
- ✓ We anticipate a 5% dues increase once the new greens open and another 5% increase in 2018
- \checkmark 25% dues credit (12 months) for sponsoring a new member to join the club
- ✓ Merchandise purchases can be made at employee pricing (regular wholesale + 10% + NC taxes)
- ✓ Special offers such as half-price guest days, free clinics, merchandise specials and dinner events
- ✓ After frozen period is over, you will have the option to prepay your dues at a 10% discount



Honoring Arnold Palmer, "The King"

An ailing Arnold Palmer's roots in western Pennsylvania run deep, especially at Oakmont, where he remains the indomitable spirit surrounding the course that will host a record ninth U.S. Open. Palmer, who was nicknamed "The King," won seven major championships during his professional career, which spanned more than five decades. He won the Masters four times, The Open twice and the U.S. Open once. "We are deeply saddened by the death of Arnold Palmer, golf's greatest ambassador," the United States Golf Association said in a statement. "Arnold Palmer will always be a champion, in every sense of the word. He inspired generations to love golf by sharing his competitive spirit, displaying sportsmanship, caring for golfers and golf fans, and serving as a lifelong ambassador for the sport.

"Our stories of him not only fill the pages of golf's history books and the walls of the museum, but also our own personal golf memories. The game is indeed better because of him, and in so many ways, will never be the same."

Born in Latrobe, Pennsylvania, in 1929, Palmer began his professional career in 1954 and quickly picked up his first Tour win with the 1955 Canadian Open in his rookie season, where his first-round 64 remained the best opening round of his career. He would go on to win 62 titles on the PGA Tour, the fifth-highest total of all time, and 92 including international and senior victories. He was PGA Player of the Year twice (1960 and '62), and the Tour's leading money winner four times, leading to total tournament earnings of nearly \$7 million.

Nicknamed "The King," Arnold Palmer won seven major championships during his professional career: the Masters four times, The Open twice and the U.S. Open once.

Palmer won the Masters in 1958, 1960, 1962 and 1964 and is one of two champions — along with Jack Nicklaus — who are members of Augusta National. Nicklaus (six) and Tiger Woods (four) are the only golfers who have won as many or more Masters titles. He developed a rivalry and lifelong friendship with Nicklaus and Gary Player, and the trio eventually became known as the "Big 3". They won seven straight Masters titles among them from 1960 to 1966, and hit ceremonial tee shots together at Augusta National to signal the start of the year's first major. Palmer hit his first ceremonial tee shot at Augusta in 2007; Nicklaus joined him in 2010, and Player was added in 2012. But Palmer slowed down in 2016 and was unable to hit his ceremonial Masters tee shot, though he did take part in the ceremony. He also did not hold his traditional pre-tourney news conference for his own tournament at Bay Hill.

Palmer's first Masters victory was in 1958, the first year soldiers from Camp Gordon were offered free admission at Augusta and helped run the scoreboards. Palmer, with his charisma, won over the soldiers and just about everyone else, and "Arnie's Army" took root. For non-golf fans, Palmer may be best known for the drink named after him, after he ordered his favorite concoction of iced tea and lemonade at a restaurant. A woman overheard him, said she would have the same thing, and the "Arnold Palmer" was born.
