Our new bermuda grass greens have fared well for the first month of being open. We are learning more about them as each week goes by. Since fall has arrived the cooler temperatures and decreased sunlight has slowed growth on all bermuda. For example just a month ago our greens could be sanded on a Monday and by Wednesday there would be so much growth that the sand would disappear. The last time we sanded nearly two weeks ago the sand hung around for a week and a half. Needless to say we will not sand anymore this year and plan to start back June of 2018.

With growth slowing and winter right around the corner heights on all playing surfaces will be raised. This simple practice will strengthen turf for the coming months. We will be able to take that a step further with the greens by covering anytime temperatures are forecasted to reach mid to high twenties. Covers help insulate the soil from freezing conditions protecting roots. Before I close I would like to mention that fall also brings leaves. The maintenance team will be out daily blowing, vacuuming and mulching leaves. Thank you all for your patience during this time. As always I can be reached at <u>rdurham@wildwoodgreen.com</u>.
