Our final 2015 core aerification is scheduled for September 8th and 9th. By pulling a core we will be providing much needed relief from compaction which in turn will allow more air and water movement into the soil profile. This cultural practice has already been completed on the practice green along with reseeding. We will keep the practice green closed until the end of September for the most success in germination and recovery. Any areas on all greens that have not healed by the end of the month will be sodded. This is also the time of year that we will be raising heights on tees, fairways and roughs. We were fortunate this past spring to only lose a small amount of turf from the hard winter. Raising heights along with a late season fertilizer application can contribute to that success. 
Friday, September 25th — Sunday, September 27th Matches start at 9:00AM Saturday & Sunday

Etiquette/Rule of Month

Rule: Preventing Unnecessary Damage

Question: How can 1 help take care of the golf course?

Answer:

- A. Players should carefully repair any divot holes made by the impact of their ball. The proper way to fix the ball mark is to push toward the middle of the mark, do not lift up!
- B. The head of the club should not be used to remove a ball from the hole.
- C. When nearing the green with a golf cart, please return to the cart path when you see the black stakes. This will prevent damage around the green.
- D. When placing the flag stick back in the hole please do not damage the sides of the cup.

It was a great weekend for golf, and an even greater weekend for Jason Day. Not only did he set a record at 20 under par, but his lifelong coach, mentor, caddie and father-figure was right by his side- as he always has been.
