Mowing heights have been adjusted and fall fertilizer applications have been made to strengthen the Bermuda grass over the next month. Even when the cooler weather arrives Bermuda will continue to grow but at a slower pace. Once this happens adjustments in mowing schedules and agronomic practices will occur. A few other items of interest this fall include irrigation improvements and sand additions to the traps. Automating tees will allow us the opportunity to apply frequent water which in turn will improve turf quality on many of the thinner tees. Many if not all bunkers are in need of more sand and this will also take place this fall. Before 1 close 1 would like to mention that fall also brings leaves.  Kevin O'Connell is yet another recovering professional golfer who found an alternate route to golf's biggest stages by winning the U.S. Mid-Amateur Championship on Thursday,
September 27<sup>th</sup>. (Kevin was member of Wildwood Green Golf Club and his father, Bud O'Connell, still is!)

In an all-North Carolinian final at Charlotte (N.C.) Country Club, O'Connell defeated Brett Boner, 4 & 3, in the 36-hole final to earn an invitation to play in the Masters and an exemption into the U.S. Open next year.

O'Connell, who resides in Cary, N.C., turned professional after playing four years at the University of North Carolina and attempted the PGA Tour Qualifying Tournament three times before giving up and filing to reclaim his amateur status.

He is, however, contemplating a return to professional golf, he said after winning the Mid-Amateur.
