
With the arrival of warmer weather you will begin to notice many changes in golf course conditions. The Bermuda grass greens are progressing well and there are only a few small areas that we may have to repair. Any repair work will come from our nursery green that is located near #18 tee box. Weekly top dressings A.K.A. "sanding" will begin shortly and the first program is scheduled for May 6th. This cultural practice can smooth, firm up, and increase speed of greens as well as control thatch making a smooth and consistent putting surface. Even with a mild winter we have a few areas that will need to be addressed. There are a handful of tees and a couple of areas in fairways that will be corrected as soon as sod becomes available. Aerifying is a cultural practice that will be ongoing over the next few months. This will help reduce compaction and allow water and air into the soil profile. This will improve root structures and help provide quality turf. The new range tee system will be installed this month and pavers have been added for bag racks. Tips from the Pro:

Struggling in the Sand Bunkers? Can't get the ball out? Here's the fix. Most players get into the shot with their chest and head pointing down which promote a downward hit resulting in chucking the sand. If you want the ball to get out you need to sweep the sand behind and through the ball. Stand over the ball and squat down like you're sitting in a chair, your chest and head will be vertical making your swing very shallow or horizontal. Crouch down so that you can get down to the sand & swing across the sand (like you're skipping a stone) into a full finish. With this move the ball will come out every time! 
