Wildwood Green Senior Interclub Team Update

The Wildwood Senior Interclub team are "a gritty group of Green grinders". On Thursday, the team won its first playoff match in four years by defeating High Point Country Club by a narrow margin of 37 to 35. The four competitors that played at High Point on the Willow Creek course combined for a total of 17.5 points, but it was not easy. Ray Griffin and Dee Blankenhorn were down by 5 points (7 - 2) after the first nine holes. However, they fought back hard. Down by 4 points with four holes left to play, it was grind time. Dee made 3 birdies to get 3 more points for a score of 8.5 to 9.5. Matt Armistead and Dennis Toothman were down by 2 points with 4 holes left to play. Matt was able to win 16 & 17 with pars. On 18 after a tap-in par for Wildwood, the opponents sank a 10 foot putt to keep the match tied at 9 to 9.

The matches that were played at Wildwood were also grinders. Trent Rhyne and Larry Key halved the first five holes, but won the next four to go 4 up. On the back nine Trent birdied 11 & 12 and Larry birdied 14 to beat a tenacious twosome by a final score of 11.5 to 6.5. Lennie Barton and Tony Herring started off very strong with a two point lead after four holes. However, their opponents collected 3 birdies on the next five holes and went up by 2 points on the front nine. Lennie birdied 11 to get one point back. After a lengthy storm delay of 1.5 hours, the opponents made a timely par on 15 to go back ahead by 2 points. The next two holes were halved. On 18, High Point sank a 50 foot bomb from the back of the green for a birdie. Lennie had a 12 footer to tie, but it just lipped out. Tony then stepped up and nailed an 8 footer for a birdie to halve the hole and a final score of 8 to 10.

The team will now go on to play Governor's Club in the second round of the playoffs which will be played on Thursday, September 5th.

Over the last two months fifteen thousand square feet of sod has been installed. We will continue to add sod through the first part of September and, as fall approaches, cool-season grasses (such as Rye and Fescue) will be seeded in many of the outer edges which will help control erosion and improve playability. There are two months left for maintenance Mondays and we plan to take full advantage of this. Last year at this time one hundred and seventy-five tons of sand had been used for top dressing greens. That amount has almost doubled this year. The Champion Bermuda greens have responded positively and continue to improve. The biggest problem this year has been cup edges. New tools have been purchased and we have increased setting hole locations to five days a week. We will continue to monitor this situation and make more adjustments if needed. Pavers at the pavilion have been completed and new benches have arrived. The benches will be assembled and added throughout course in the coming weeks.
