We haven't had many yet, be we are sure to get some mornings where the course must open late due to frost. We will give you **45 minutes of notice to get to the property** on these mornings and here is an example of how things will run during frost delay mornings:

9:00 AM - Scheduled first tee time.

8:00 AM - Golf shop arrives on property.

8:15 AM - Maintenance informs us we are under a frost delay.

8:20 AM - Golf shop updates the phone message, Facebook, and Clubster with the frost delay information:

Good morning members - we are currently under a frost delay and will receive our next update from the Superintendent at 9:30 AM.

9:30 AM - Golf shop posts again to facebook and clubster and updates the phone message as needed:

Good morning again members - we have heard from maintenance and we will be able to begin today at 10:15 AM. For tee times that were scheduled 10:15 AM and prior, you will begin at 10:15 AM as a forward shotgun start. For tee times scheduled after 10:15 AM, you will begin off hole #1 as normal.

Because we host a forward shotgun start for play prior to the shotgun, there will be some groups that need to make the turn to hole #1 and complete the holes not played. We will run the 1st tee like a four-way stop sign allowing one group making the turn to go and then allowing a scheduled tee time to go. I apologize in advance if your tee time gets pushed by a few minutes but hosting play this way allows everyone to get on the course as quickly as possible with the least amount of delay as possible. You would much rather be pushed back by 15 minutes than an hour and fifteen minutes, I assure you!

<u>Rick Durham – Superintendent</u>

Leaf cleanup continues with many leaves still to come down. Weather permitting, we will have multiple blowers out on the course daily along with a mulching unit and vacuum. I know many of you have noticed that we have taken the tarps out and placed them on the course. Over the next few weeks we will practice unfolding and placing on the greens. This allows us the opportunity to position and mark the tarps, so when time comes to cover we can be more efficient. A popular question I receive is at what temperature do we cover? There are several factors that go into this decision. We will be on alert when temperatures begin to approach twenty five degrees for lows. Moisture levels, ground temperatures and how long temperatures are below twenty five all factor into the decision to cover. Last year at this time we were removing additional trees on a few greens that struggled during the cold winter of 2017/2018. Removing the trees has been beneficial with the overall health of the greens reflecting this. Tree removal continues this winter with the installation of new cart paths. Any trees that do not allow us to use our root pruner will be removed. In certain situations the cart path will be rerouted away from trees. Irrigation has been an ongoing project over the past year. With all of the tees automated we will now focus on fairways. The old manual heads are being removed and heads with the ability of automation installed. To cause less disruption we will not install any wiring until spring which will give areas a quicker time to recover. I would like to thank all of you for your comments and suggestions.
