Phase 2 at Wildwood Green

We have adjusted some of our procedures and rules at the club recently. Some general rules that we ask you follow when visiting Wildwood Green are also listed below. We thank you for your patronage and look forward to seeing you at the club soon!

While Visiting Wildwood Green Golf Club

Per the Governor's mandate effective Friday, June 26th, face masks are now required when entering the Clubhouse. Face masks are required in the golf shop, Champions Grille, or anywhere that social distancing cannot be kept. If you do not have a face mask, please wait outside and call (919) 846-8376 ext 2.

•If you are sick or have been experiencing a cough or fever - Stay home.

•Wash and sanitize your hands frequently.

•Call in your food & beverage order to 919-390-0347.

•Adhere to social distancing guidelines.

•Limit interactions between yourself and others.

•Avoid loitering inside of the clubhouse or grille.

•Dispose of your own trash.

•Return your golf cart immediately after your round.

•Leave the flagstick in the hole while putting.

•Smooth any bunkers with your club and foot.

•Minimize any trips inside as much as possible.



Golf Shop Operation Changes

The golf shop will open 30 minutes prior to the first tee time and will close at 7:30 PM.
Members and guests are allowed inside of the golf shop - limit of 4 customers.
Two golfers may ride together in the same golf cart. Golf carts will be given out on a first come, first serve basis and anytime walking is still allowed.
Golf carts will be allowed to go out until 7:30 PM. After 7:30 it will be walking only.
Over the phone check in is encouraged!

•Locker rooms will be open for use.

Driving Range Operation Changes

•The driving range will open 30 minutes prior to the first tee time and will close at 7:30 PM. •The last bucket of range balls will be sold at 7:00 PM.

•On Sundays the last bucket of range balls will still be sold at 5:00 PM.

•Range ball purchases may still be made over the phone or at the golf shop counter.

•The putting green at the driving range has reopened for use.



Champions Grille Operation Changes

•Two tables will be set up for dining inside of the clubhouse and three tables will be set up on the back patio. Sit down dining is limited to groups of 10 people or less.
•There will be a maximum of 8 people at the sit down tables inside of Champions Grille.
•New grille hours will begin on Sunday, May 31st where we will be open from 9:00 AM until 7:00 PM. On Mondays the grille will be open from 10:30 AM until 7:00 PM.

What We Are Continuing To Do

•Sanitizing golf carts between each use.

- •Shared items on the golf course and practice facilities have been removed.
- •Encouraging social distancing and allowing walking at anytime.
- •Washing and sanitizing hands frequently.
- •Sanitizing the facility frequently.
- •Encouraging over the phone check in.

Dear Members,

We were happy to hear that North Carolina could move to Phase 2 in late May which brought some looser restrictions with it. Unfortunately, North Carolina was not successful in reducing the number of COVID cases over the following 6 weeks and are now stuck in Phase 2 for a bit longer.

As per state mandate, masks are required for everyone when social distancing cannot be kept. There are a few exceptions to this however, you MUST wear a face covering when entering the clubhouse. Whether it be for golf or food, please bring your face mask with you and on when you come inside.

During the month of June we had more than 58 complete foursome no-shows from members alone. This equates to 236 lost golfers or \$4,720 in revenue. This is becoming a normalcy rather than an exception and we cannot continue on this path. If this does continue, along with the cost of the many improvements we are making, we will be forced to raise dues prices more than the small 3-5% you have seen in the past. These no shows are more than \$50,000 annually! Please be considerate of the cost of course improvements as well as your fellow members who, just like you, want to get out and play golf!

Thank you for your attention to this, for being a member, and your participation in our events. We are eager to get back to normal as I know you are.

Summer heat has arrived and appears to be here to stay for a while. Maintenance Mondays have proved to be beneficial for greens and they will only continue to get better. We have an aggressive dethatching scheduled July 6th and 7th (9 holes will be open each day). There will be a slight disruption on the putting surfaces but recovery time will be quick. This cultural practice is taking the place of normal aerification this year.

Sod work has been underway over the last few weeks and we hope to install one more truck load. Other improvements have been completed such as step replacement on holes eight and thirteen. Steps on nine will be repaired along with adding steps on fourteen. Landscaping has been a focus in June and will continue to improve into July.
