2020 was an atrocious year, let's be honest. We are all glad it is now in the rear-view mirror and 2021 is upon us. It marks a time for new beginnings and improvements and gives us a chance to start fresh. I hope you and your family had a happy holiday season!

We have set a **tentative member event schedule** but will need to finalize some dates in the months of September-November due to the college football schedule. We know that these days take a great amount of you away from the club, so we are trying to plan our events accordingly to maximize our event players. We should have a final schedule out near the end of February after the 2021 football schedules are released. Sunshine is busy planning some food & beverage events for you to partake in during the rest of the winter. We hope to have our pavilion finished by March 1st as well as the back patio. **2020 has finally come to an end.** The year has presented many challenges as you all know. Agronomically one of the biggest has been the amount of rainfall. North Carolina set record for total rainfall this year. With the ground being so saturated, projects have been delayed. Paving will

continue once we have dried out sufficiently and hopefully that will be soon. **There are plans to** dredge the pond on five and twelve. These two projects are contracted out and our maintenance team will continue with the irrigation project. All the irrigation heads have been installed. Wiring and control box installation remains to be completed. This will be a major improvement giving us the ability to irrigate when needed and maximize agronomic applications. A few smaller items that we have been working on include refurbishing tee markers and ball washers. We also have plans to add sand to our bunkers!

With winter months approaching we are always watching forecast for cold temperatures. As you all know our greens do not hold up well under these conditions. We have been fortunate in this aspect over the past year with only having to cover twice for a total of eight days. Once was last January, and the other was just a few weeks ago in December. Cover or not to cover is always a tough call. We must consider how long the low temperature will remain extremely low. Moisture levels are a factor. Happy New Year from all of us at The Golf Academy at Wildwood Green! Our best wishes for a healthy and rewarding new year. With the holidays behind us, let's start thinking about you and your golf goals for 2021 and beyond. Scoring better is the result of being better at aspects of your game

that have been neglected or not practiced properly. We can help you identify these areas and give you a targeted approach to improvement. More consistent tee shots, better approach shots to the correct side of the green, better and more options for chipping and pitching inside 50 yards, better speed on putts, reading greens more accurately, and making more putts that you should make. Any or all of these could make a difference in your score with efficient practice by you after our guidance. Let's get started soon, lots can be done in cooler weather to get your game in shape!

Our 2021 Programs kickoff with our Junior Winter Skills classes. Classes are available in age groups 7-10 on Tuesday, Wednesday (currently full) and Thursday.
