Update from the Owner

Hello to all the members who have tried to put up with the rain and played a few rounds in soggy January. We appreciate all the nice compliments regarding the improvements, customer service and our switch from golf shop merchandise apparel to primarily golf items. Here is an update on what we have in the works:

PATIO:

The awning is completed, new high top tables and chairs are already onsite, but we have to either cover the bricks or repair the grout between the bricks prior to placing the furniture. We have installed the market lights. The fire pit is working nicely. The outside service window has been ordered and should be installed soon along with an awning over that service area. The electricity and plumbing have been installed to move the ice/ water machine outside when the weather is suitable.

PAVILION:

We discovered a leak in the concrete pad and brick area. The contractor has promised a quick waterproof fix and should actually be finished by the time you receive this newsletter. Repair to the outside wood trim, sealing the windows, inside and outside painting, boxing in the inside columns, electrical work, flooring and furnishings will follow. Unfortunately we are unable to obtain water/sewer service to the pavilion at this time. We are working on temporary and permanent restrooms. Hopefully we will be able

to enjoy the area by March. Look for an exciting announcement from Jeff and Dan regarding TrackMan and club fitting for this area!

GOLF COURSE & GROUNDS:

New lights are ordered to be installed near the Pavilion and one near the parking lot. We are at Dukes mercy. Unfortunately, we are unable to complete the cart path repairs on holes 2,3,4,13,14,15 (when finished we will spend over \$400,000 on cart paths and parking) and some select spots on holes that only need some patching at this time due to the wet conditions. Enjoy the smooth ride, if you are one of the golfers that actually uses the cart paths! No work on paths will restart until the course dries out.

GOLF COURSE & GROUNDS:

The cleaning of the pond on #5 will be delayed until we can make a few bucks because we have an unexpected \$19,500 drainage repair across #13 & #5. The work planned at #12 lake and forward tee, plus the academy tee renovation are still on schedule.

The installation of the water cooler stands at #16 is completed and #4 will start after the cart path work is completed in that area.

New coolers and cooler stands have been ordered along with many more golf course and range accessories. We are installing GPS on the golf carts and will be limiting the areas where carts can enter. We have tried to regulate cart traffic in order to protect the golfers in the carts and the conditions of the course. We obviously failed since carts are driven within a few feet of greens and tees, in areas when wet, on sides of dangerous slopes, in newly seeded areas, wooded areas, across drainage ditches and even behind #2,4,8,10,11,12,13 greens. IF YOU NEED A HANDICAP FLAG, see Jeff regarding a letter from your Doctor or a copy of your auto handicap display and license plate photo.

FOOD & BEVERAGE:

Sunshine and her staff are doing outstanding. The comments from the 50 folks who enjoyed the Spaghetti dinner has been outstanding. Sandy and I enjoyed it. I loved that pineapple cake too. Champions Grille staff are always willing to prepare your special requests. Please call in your orders.

Beginning by daylight savings time we are going to ask that no outside coolers, food, beverage be brought onto club grounds, especially alcohol!!!! We continue to try to provide our members with the best service, conditions and value possible. If we fall short we want to know. Comment Cards are provided on golf carts and other areas around the club. We see these every week and do our best to react to your comments!

Along with the facility and course improvements (patio awning, pavilion, cart paths, landscaping, etc.) we are excited to announce that we will soon be purchasing a TrackMan 4 unit to put into the pavilion area. This will allow you to **virtually play** several big-name course such as Pebble Beach, Bellerive Country Club, **Innisbrook Copperhead, St. Andrews** and more! This will also allow us an area to fit your game with detailed swing specs. Jimmy, Dan, and the other instructors are excited to have this opportunity to fit your entire game here at Wildwood and offer a place to play, practice, and get fit even during the colder months of the year. We can do everything at Wildwood Green with this implementation of the **Trackman unit!**

We are nearly complete on finalizing the Member Event schedule for the year. The 2021 NCAA Football schedule was recently released and we had to adjust a few events later this year. Superintendent – Rick Durham

Wet conditions continue to be the theme. This time of year, **it does not take much moisture to saturate the course**. We have had one small break which enabled us to install irrigation wires on hole five. We still have eight holes to go and if it ever dries out we will continue with this project.

There is one unexpected project that had to be planned for ASAP. A section of the underground drainage system has failed on hole 5. Instead of repairing the one section we have **decided to replace entire system**. The drainage pipe begins at 13 cart path and runs under 13 fairway. There is a catch basin in between 5 and 13. From there drainage system empties into the pond at 5. The old existing metal pipe will be replaced with double wall plastic with two new catch basins. Once the pipes and catch basins have been replaced, the area will be sodded. This will help with heavy water flow during large rain events.

The rain has **postponed cart path work** until weather improves. Heavy equipment used to pave would cause more damage than good.

Head Teaching Professional – Dan Alton

It's no surprise that your handicap goes up during the winter months. With the temperature below 65 degrees the ball doesn't fly as far, the ground conditions make it tough to chip & pitch etc...So what can you do?? Start by playing a low compression ball for the remainder of the winter. Callaway SuperSoft's are the lowest compression ball out there at about 35\40...EVERYONE OF ALL SWING SPEEDS will benefit from this during sub 60 temps. Next, hit one more club no matter what, from there you just need to make some putts. If it's a little cold for you to start taking swing lessons...putting lessons aren't a bad idea. This is the perfect time to be getting your short game ready for spring conditions. We can make sure you have the correct arc for your stroke & make sure you have the correct putter fit for said arc.



If you're ready to start **lowering scores** take advantage of our Book on-line feature. If you're booking for a Junior, send either myself or Asst. Pro, Nathan Feibes an Email and we will get them set up with his schedule. **Looking forward to getting back to the Spring weather, we're almost there!**
