Update from the Owner

R ain please give us a break!! The rain has really interrupted all of our winter work. For those of you that have found a way to play golf you must need a new pair of golf shoes! Thanks for playing and participating in the winter events.

Now for a quick update of our improvements:

- The irrigation work has been delayed, but left some time for the crew to spruce up a number of items throughout the clubhouse and course areas. Pine straw looks great. Thanks Rick and maintenance staff!
- The drainage work on #5 and #13 has been delayed. Waiting to dry out to complete.
- The work at #12 tee/ lake area has been de-

layed. Waiting to dry out to complete.

- Cart path paving on #2, 3, 4, 13, 14 & 15 has been delayed and will continue when it dries out.
- The teaching tee area at the back of the range has also been delayed. Waiting to dry out.
- All new course accessories (water coolers and stands, sand bottle holders, bunker rakes, club cleaners, bag racks, scorecard holder, sand boxes) are being placed on the course as time and weather permits.
- The ice/water machine at the course restrooms area will be installed during April.
- At least two light poles

will be installed on the clubhouse grounds in anticipation of more evening use of the club after dark.

- We are gathering bids on cleaning the lake on #5 and installing a fence between the range and #1 fairway. We hope to complete at least one of these by July.
- The patio furniture is onsite and will be placed before April. The ice/ water machine will be relocated from the grille to the patio, a new service window will be added at the grille to improve turn time and service to golfers.

- The pavilion completion has been delayed until it is waterproofed and a permit is secured for the electrical supply to install the HVAC. The flooring, TV, bar are all onsite. No restrooms can be installed at this time, however we are looking at temporary restrooms. Repairs and painting are scheduled shortly.
- Have you seen the golf shop renovation and new golf merchandise on display? Try some of the Taylormade golf balls at an unbelievable sale price!! Thanks to Jeff and Nathan for making all these improvements!
- Zach is busy keeping the communication going out so members don't miss any events, offers or special sale items. Great job on communications Zach!

General Manager Update

Dear Members,

March is upon us and longer days are within view! COVID cases are dropping and vaccines are rolling out. All GREAT news!

It feels like just yesterday we were changing the operations at Wildwood to accommodate state regulations which have recently eased. North Carolina is in a better spot now than we have been for several months. Everyone knock on wood!!

We dealt with an ever-changing landscape over the past year and I appreciate all of the staff's help as well as yours, for us being able to stay open and operate. It has been a tough 12 months for so many people and my heart goes out to them. Thank you for being committed to the club and being the reason we have been able to make so many wonderful improvements. It is really exciting to see the changes take place over the past four years. New greens - limiting weekend mornings to members and their guests - better facility all around - more in-stock hard goods - better food - better events - better carts - It has all come together for us here and we hope you are proud of your facility!

With what Roger listed in his article about upcoming improvements, I have a few things to announce as well. Beginning March 1st we are implementing a capital dues of \$10 per month, per membership. These capital dues will be earmarked for use on capital improvement items and provide an overall better facility for you to be a member. Your membership dues are not being increased at this time

Cart fees will also be adjusted. The new price will be \$21.85 for 18 holes and \$13.60 for 9 holes. You can still join the annual cart plan and prepay for these if you would like. If you would like to do so, please see Zach in the golf shop to get it taken care of.

We are going to be implementing new software in April which will hopefully alleviate the issues we have seen with online bookings and provide a smoother process overall. With the launch of the new software we will implement a 3% surcharge for all credit card transactions beginning May 1st. If you are currently using a credit card to pay your monthly fees or daily fees, please let us know if you want to change that beginning in May so that your credit card is not drafted. You can always pay by cash or check to avoid these surcharge fees.

Mother Nature has continued to challenge us over this past month. We have had to **delay several projects and even some daily maintenance due to wet conditions.** Some of the daily maintenance delays has included bunkers and general cleanup. **All efforts are being made to improve these areas.**

Two of our larger projects that have been delayed are irrigation and cart paths. **Irrigation will resume the latter part of March.** Cart path renovation has been a struggle scheduling and will start again once the course has a chance to dry out.

We have also been unable to apply a pre-emergent to the golf course. Out initial target date for this was February 22nd. Due to the wet conditions we have **postponed until March 16th**. This application will help control summer annual weeds. This application is vital to keeping the course weed free and promoting a healthier turf.

As we get into March, please be sure you are keeping an eye on our Clubster and E-blast updates, as we will be changing the driving range hours, and the first tee time will be moving up.
