



Have you seen or used the new pass -through window to Champions Grille? Simply call in your order and come up to the window on the patio to pick up your food. It cannot be easier than that!



One of the more common questions I am currently receiving is "when will the fairways green up"? Fairways, tees and rough have been in a dormant state since last November. Green up and recovery in these areas will begin when nighttime temperatures remain above 60 degrees for several days and soil temperatures reach 65 degrees at a 4 inch depth. Averages for March nighttime and soil temperatures are high 30's to low 40's. As we advance into spring significant changes occur mid to late May. If you look close some changes have already begun. Greens recover much quicker due to mowing height and soil temperatures are warmer because we have covered our greens when extremely cold.

A quick update on our irrigation project - holes 1, 2, 3, 5, 7 & 8 are complete. We are projecting to have 9, 13, 14 & 15 complete this spring. I look forward to seeing all of you out on the links!

The Golf Academy at Wildwood Green

Our Operation 36 Adult and Junior Golfer Development Program is off to a great start for 2021 with over 130 participants over 23 different classes. The summer semester will begin the week of June 14 with registration beginning April 20 for returning families and May 1 for new families. Information and class schedules will be available on the Academy webpage at raleighgolflessons.com by April 15.

PGA Junior League registration is underway at pgajrleague.com, search the Wildwood Green team page. We are planning on having an in house league this year for U13 ages 8-13, cannot turn 14 before July 31, and U17 ages 14-17, cannot turn 18 before July 31. This will be a fun playing opportunity and is great for beginners into more experienced players wanting to get a taste of competition. Play is done with 2 person teams playing a captains choice format against another 2 person team. We will have 3-4 U13 teams and 2-3 U17 teams. **Registration is open until April 15** with organizational events now on April 15 at 6:45pm and April 17 at 6:00pm. Events will be held from mid May through the end of June later on Saturday afternoons and practices held on the Thursday evenings before events.


