Members - What a fantastic start to the year! We have had great success with our membership drive. I will be updating you on the full numbers soon, but we have surpassed the first 50 spot and are hard at work planning a social to feature the drawing for "Free Dues for Life". This will ONCE AGAIN give you an opportunity to lower your monthly dues to the club and help build Wildwood Green for the long term.

As you may have noticed, we implemented new software during the last week of April in the Golf Shop, Champions Grille, and online tee time engines. Thank you for being patient with myself and the staff! We still have a few bugs to fix and we are learning the system more and more each day. **As an FYI due to security reasons, no credit cards were able to be transferred into the new system. When you have time, please drop by the golf shop to add your card on file.**

One thing I do need to mention is the amount of no-shows we are seeing. **We are averaging close to 16 players today simply not showing up.** I ask that you please inform the golf shop of your intentions to bring less than what you booked. This will greatly help us maximize the tee sheet for everyone's enjoyment and further continue to help upgrade around the facility. We could easily be putting \$200 per day additional into facility improvements for you if we could eliminate these no shows and fill them with members and guest alike.

Inconsistent weather and traffic has slowed some areas from becoming green. We expect conditions to improve as weather becomes warmer. To assist changes we will begin aerifications, apply fertilizers and setup watering schedules. These types of cultural practices can be done during our normal operating hours. Greens can be difficult. Time is needed to topdress, verticut and drag in for play that day. We have scheduled Maintenance Mondays to begin so this can be achieved. The course will open for play at 11:00 to provide the maintenance time to complete these cultural practices. These cultural practices are important to control thatch, speed and firmness. Combined with weekly fertility applications our greens will continue to improve!
