We are in the meat of the season now and the course is **looking great.** Kudos to Rick Durham and the maintenance team for all their hard work! We recently completed (or will very soon) cart path repair work on #13, #14, #15, #1, #2, #3, #4, #5, #7 and #9. This completes the work we had planned for over this past winter. **I hope you enjoy the smooth ride!** Thank you for your patience as we completed this. Even though there are some spots we still need to clean up, we will be much better off for years to come.

I hope to see you at our events in the coming weeks. We still have three majors left for the year and one begins at the end of the month. The Club Championship is always a well-attended event and is the most prestigious event we host. Be sure to sign up early and prepare for a challenging weekend!

I hope you have noticed the signs throughout the facility regarding where your capital dues are going. We recently completed capital improvements at the pavilion, back patio, drainage repair between #5/ #13, and the instructional tee. We still need to complete the #12 forward tee area and the hillside area on #5 where the lake dredging took place. Please note that these signs are informative to let you know that we could not make these improvements without vou! If you would like to see an improvement around the facility, fill out a comment card for us. These get picked up weekly and distributed among the Managers and Owners.

Summer heat has arrived and appears to be here to stay for a while. Maintenance Mondays have proved to be beneficial for greens and they will only continue to get better. We have a small aerification scheduled for Tuesday, July 6th. There will be a slight disruption on the putting surfaces, but recovery time will be quick. This cultural practice will reduce compaction and allow water and air to infiltrate into the soil profile. Weather has played a role regarding completion of many of the projects that we have ongoing. Cart path paving should be complete by the first few days of July. Once finished there will be cleanup and repair work to be completed behind the contractors. The forward tees on twelve will be expanded and sodded in July. There will be various other areas that will have sod added thru July. There are four holes left to automate the irrigation and this will resume in the fall. 

Food & Beverage: There is an OP-TIONAL boxed lunch both days - please let us know at time of sign up if you would like one!

Flighting: The Club Championship will be flighted by age and then by handicap. No handicaps will be used in competition, except for the NET Division. The Net Division will not be flighted.

Divisions:

Championship Division (Any male) - **Blue Tees**

Men's Division (Men 59 and younger) - **White Tees**

Senior Division (Men 60-74) - Gold Tees

Super Senior (Men 74 and older) - **Green Tees**

Ladies Division - Red Tees

Net Division - Most commonly played tee set

NOTE: You may elect to move UP to any division you like, but may not move BACK in divisions (ex: A 66-year old is able to play in the Championship or Men's division, but may NOT play in the Super Senior Division.)




