A controlled scalping was performed on the putting surfaces to help reduce grain and thatch. Mowers will be adjusted, and our greens will continue to improve as the summer winds down.

Projects in 2021 are beginning to come together. One of the larger improvements has been cart path paving. With all the asphalt down, we now will focus on cleaning up the edges and backfilling. Twelve forward tee was completed at the end of July and should be open for play in the coming weeks. **Irrigation work will resume in the fall with only four holes left to complete.**








Operations Manager — Tommy Himebaugh

As fall approaches, our Operation 36 Fall Semester has nearly reached capacity in record time. There are some openings remaining in adult and age 3-6 classes at this time. Our PGA Junior League 13U team finished the season with a 2-2 mark and All Star selections Eli Wofford and Andrew Kennedy played very well in the regional event shooting 33 for 9 holes but the team fell just short of advancing to the section event. The 17U All Star team will be advancing to the section event being 1 of only 2 teams entering. This will be August 12 at Mid Pines resort in Pinehurst.

Academy student Kaitlyn Rand, is one of 81 juniors selected to participate in the PGA Tour Champions Pure Insurance Championship as part of the First Tee partnership with that event held in September at Pebble Beach in California. Xan Pitt and Sadler Miller were winners in their divisions at the Jack Ratz TYGA Championship held at Wildwood Green. Our juniors are playing well in numerous events including a 9 hole score of 29 posted by Braedan Wright in a recent Operation 36 On Course Challenge Event.

As your playing continues this fall, be aware of elements of your game that are keeping you from scoring your best. 
