I hope everyone had an enjoyable holiday season and a few weeks of fun in the snow! We were able to uncover the greens on January 31st and the extended forecast has us not covering again for the foreseeable future. Good news for you winter golfers!

Nathan has published our 2022 events calendar. Some of the dates from September-November are dependent on the release of the college football schedule. We try not to schedule events when there is a home State of UNC game. Once the schedule is made public, we can double check our schedule and adjust as needed.

After a mild December, winter has decided to show up in January. Ground temperatures are lower and for this reason we have covered greens for eleven days in January. The covers are not permeable. In between the eleven days we removed covers to apply water to keep moisture levels adequate. During this time, the maintenance team has not been idle.

Irrigation wires have been installed on 11 and 16. With holes 10 and 18 remaining we will make a push to complete this project in February. Tree removal has also been ongoing. This project will improve turf conditions, playability, and safety. Matthews tree service has removed over fifteen trees with ten remaining. I am looking forward to wrapping up these two projects and moving forward with continued improvement of our facilities.




1st Assistant — Nathan Feibes



- Chocolate Cherry Cake



Registration is fully underway for our spring semester of Operation 36. If a class mentioned in the information does not appear in the registration dashboard, that means it is full and you should select another class. We are offering 24 classes on different days and times and have close to 70 returning families already registered. We will do all we can to provide sufficient class space for our families. There are 3 classes for adults so get yourself and your juniors in on the FUN!




