Members,

March is here and before you know it, the temperatures will be consistently warm and the grass will be turning green. **Rick, Rex, and the rest of maintenance team** have done a great job keeping us clean and in good shape this winter. The clubhouse grounds and flower beds were recently **prepped for fresh pine straw** to be laid. Those flowers will begin blooming before you know it!

Beginning in March you will have a chance to lower your monthly dues by sponsoring a new member to join the club....you will even be entered to win two years of FREE membership dues with each new member sponsored! Our 2022 Two Years Free Dues membership drive will officially launch March 1st. With the sponsorship of a new member, you will receive a statement credit of 25% of the new member's dues off your dues for 12 months. More information will be sent via email in the coming days and we will have new member packets at the golf shop counter for you.

Please know that we try to maintain a low dues structure while providing a high quality product. **Beginning April 1st** we will be having a **5% membership dues and services increase including range fees and cart fees.** Capital dues will remain the same. Beginning March 13th, we will have an increase of daily play rates. Any new member joining the club will be doing so under these new rates. For those of you who have prepaid 2022, your dues rates are locked in through that time period.


Superintendent — Rick Durham

I am pleased to announce that our irrigation project is complete. Wildwood green is now fully automated! This improvement will allow us to maximize all chemical and fertilizer applications that need to have irrigation. In the past we relied on mother nature and sometimes she did not cooperate. Moisture management will improve with the ability to irrigate overnight and not interfere with play.

Now that this project is behind us, we will be focusing on our landscaped areas. Club ground shrubs are being trimmed and beds are being cleared for fresh pine straw. Natural areas on the golf course will be clear cut and sprayed. Over thirty trees were removed this year. The majority of these were on the left side of hole fifteen. These trees have been removed to improve playability and sunlight. We plan to renovate fifteen tee boxes later this spring to provide a larger, better quality tee surface. With spring right around the corner, the maintenance team is committed to improving Wildwood Green.




No Smoking Under The Patio!
