We slow a bit with events during the month of July with aerification following the holiday. We will have 9 holes open on the 5th and 6th so that the maintenance team can complete the necessary work on the greens. We should be looking great in roughly 10 days!!

We have many improvements coming up during the remainder of the year and we thank you for your patience as we complete them. We have started clearing the area near the driving range in anticipation of installing a fitting bay and a simulator bay. Hand rails will be installed on the course very soon, and we are looking at building an observation deck near the pavilion. Great things are happening and we thank you for helping to contribute to them!






#### **Superintendent — Rick Durham**

Our golf course is showing the results of a hot dry June. Newly installed irrigation helps but there is nothing like water from Mother Nature. The pump station has been working overtime and the pond levels reflect the amount of water that it has applied to the golf course. Fortunately, we have received a small amount of rain of late and the forecast looks a little better in the coming weeks. Even with hot dry conditions we have repaired several areas with sod and have plans for more this coming month. July is also the month we get more aggressive with cultural practices on greens and tees. July 5th and 6th there will be only nine holes open each day. An aerification and deep dethatching will be performed by the maintenance team on greens. Aerification holes will be small and will aide in water and air penetrating into the soil profile. Our focus is the de-thatching process which will alleviate grain. I expect the recovery time to be short during this time. Tee aerification will relieve compaction and provide more opportunities in coverage of turf. With the success and response of the renovation that our maintenance team completed on fifteen tee there are plans to do more. Three, six, nine are examples of tees that are not large enough to manage the amount of play that we have. As we continue to improve, I would like to thank everyone for their comments and suggestions. As always, you can contact me at rdurham@wildwoodgreen.com.



I am working on lots of fun events for all to enjoy, one of which will be music on the green. Stay tuned for up coming dates and times.


We have started selling drinks and snacks at the range and half way house on the weekends. Please stop by and get a refreshment!

#### **July 2022 Newsletter**

Our colleague, mentor to many, friend to all and family man Ronnie Reitz passed away on June 17th. Ronnie helped us with our Operation 36 program and could be seen helping people on the range. Ronnie was a great player winning the Pennsylvania High School Championship with a mix and match set of clubs. He was a Conrad Weiser High School Hall of Famer in 3 sports. Ronnie played the PGA Tour and was in the field for the 1967 PGA Championship at Columbine CC in Denver. Ronnie served as Head Professional at several area clubs over the decades including Louisburg CC, North Ridge CC, Wake Forest CC and River Ridge CC. In recent years Ronnie was teaching at area facilities including WilMar GC, Capital Golf Center, Capitol Tee Golf Center and here at Wildwood Green. Ronnie was a great innovator in the field of junior golf and was recognized at both the Carolinas PGA and National PGA level. Ronnie was recognized as the Carolinas PGA Teacher of the Year in 1984. Until his sudden passing Ronnie was helping with juniors and helping adults with their game. He will be greatly missed!!

Our summer semester of Operation 36 is in full swing with classes at capacity. The fall semester information will be on our Academy webpage, raleighgolflessons.com, on the Programs/Junior Programs page by July 4th. New family registration will begin on the Operation 36 platform on August 1 at 6am. New families can follow the directions on the Academy information page referenced above to set up a family administrative page and student page for their juniors. Classes will be available at all levels from ages 3-6 in the Future 36'ers, New Golfers, Intermediate Golfers and Advanced Golfers and adults.



### **Aerification Scheduled**



On Tuesday, July 5<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday, July 6<sup>th</sup> we will have nine holes open each day for aerification. This necessary process will dethatch the green surface and pull the core of the root structure underneath the green's surface. By pulling the core we will allow air and water to penetrate the root structure and strengthen the green surfaces for the remainder of the year.

We also have a net division that will use a handicap however, players in this flight MUST have a GHIN handicap.










#### No Smoking Under The Patio!
