As we near the end of summer we are excited to announce our 2023 prepayment program! This program is an **integral part of our planning process** for the upcoming year. It allows us to **make improvements** to the facility in the off season and helps us plan and **prepare for the following calendar year.** We hope that you will be able to **take advantage of this program** and save money on your 2023 dues and services! July has produced much needed precipitation. Our golf course has been on the dry side for the early part of summer. The irrigation project that we completed this year has been beneficial. By being able to irrigate early in the season we have been able to establish a healthy turf. During the drought, the pond levels dropped, and we had to go on the conservative side of irrigating. With our irrigation pond levels up and a normal summer rain pattern developing I do not foresee any issues for the remainder of the summer. The maintenance team has been busier than ever over these last two months. With the core of our golf course coming into form we will be focusing on our outer edges. We plan to install one more round of sod to correct bare areas in roughs and on cart path edges. Other projects that will be beginning to include repairing the ditch on number two, continuing landscaping improvements and freshening up sand traps. 
