Members,

What a wonderful year we had. I hope your holiday season was a fun and enjoyable as mine and I wish you a prosperous new year!

Thank you so much for your support of the member holiday fund this year. It was by far the biggest contribution I have seen to date and it truly made the staff feel appreciated. We will be sending thank you letters in the mail soon to those of you who donated.

Late in December I sent a note regarding a small dues and professional services increase. Those were implemented on January 1st, 2023. We appreciate your loyalty as a member of our facility and your understanding of this slight increase to keep developing our operation moving forward. We have several capital improvements we are trying to complete in 2023 including finishing of the cart paths at #8, #11, and #12. Once those three areas are finished, we will have resurfaced or installed new cart path throughout the entire operation including the parking lots.

Our current membership is open to 25 new members joining the facility or March 1st, whichever comes first. In March we plan to launch a new membership drive that will allow you to lower your monthly dues rate and/or give you member credits for future use by sponsoring new members of the club. At that time, we plan to cap certain membership categories and only offer a combination of Regular, Executive, and Junior Executive memberships. We will also have higher initiation fees at that time. We hope you will put your family and friends on notice to join now before it is too late!

We experienced our first shot of **cold temperatures** over Christmas for the first time in **several years**. Greens were **cov**ered to protect them from the frigid weather. High winds caused some minor damage throughout the course with clean up ongoing. **Clearing on 3, 4, and 5** is almost complete. This has made an improvement in aesthetics. There are plans to stabilize the creeks with rip rap to help improve water flow and minimize erosion. Paving will also resume with only three holes **remaining**. Unfortunately, we will have to **close nine holes** to complete this project. We will try to notify you in advance as to when this will take place. We apologize for the inconvenience and thank you for your patience and under**standing** during this time. Many **improvements** were made in 2022 and we haven't finished yet. More to come in 2023 with some bunker renovations and equipment upgrades. Let's hope that all the **cold weather** is **behind** us, and we start the new year off with a lot of time on the links! You must win a CGA Super Senior tournament in NC or SC to qualify for this yearend TOC, making it one of the regions most prestigious amateur golf tournaments.

Dee was fortunate to win a tournament held at Duke University in June which gained him eligibility for the Tournament of Champions. Dee shot a 36 on the front and stated he was pleased with that....but

was ecstatic to hit every fairway and green in regulation on the back. Leading to a back nine 31 from Dee that was fueled by 4 birdies, giving him a 3 under round of 67...the crown was his!

This was Dee's 7th try to win this tournament and he's had a 2nd and a 3rd along the way. "Been fortunate to win several CGA Senior events over the years, but this was my best win, no doubt" said Dee after the victory. Wildwood always has and continues to be "Where Champions Play" and members like Dee help us prove that each and every year. 
