Members,

Unfortunately this winter hasn't been too great for golf. We have had a serious amount of rain! Although it has been wet, we have been able to complete some projects around the facility including some cart path work, the clearing on #2 -#3-#4-#5, our 2023 Member Event Schedule, and a reorganize of the golf shop.

We have our first member event of the year this month on **February 25th**. There is room for 80 players so be sure to register early for it! There are 3 bingo nights left—two in February and one before the time change in March. They have been well attended this winter!

Friday-Sunday shotguns will continue until the time change in March which is at **2:00 AM on the morning of March 12th**. After that, we will switch back and host tee times each day of the week. Friday-Sunday will have an earlier start.

Our range hours will change this month. Our last bucket of balls will be sold at 5:00 PM Monday-Saturday and at 3:00 PM on Sunday. The driving range will have a hard closing time of 30 minutes AFTER the last bucket is sold. Sundays we perform a clean pick of the range so we appreciate your understanding of the earlier closing time.

At the end of the month I plan to have details out on our spring membership drive. We will have higher initiation fees and begin to cap some membership categories. **Through February we have the 1 of 25 Membership Drive going**. #### **Superintendent — Rick Durham**

Weather this winter has been up and down. We have had extreme cold, warmer than normal temperatures, and more moisture it seems than recent years. Fortunately, the form of moisture has been rain and not snow or ice. With the wet conditions we have not been able to move forward with paving cart paths. The three holes remaining are eight, eleven and twelve. Forecast are being monitored and as soon as there is a break in weather we will move forward with completing this project. Mother nature hasn't prevented other projects to slow down. The clearing of the creek between three, four and five along with clearing behind three green is ongoing. There have been several other areas where trees have been removed. Improving outer edges for play and aesthetics will continue to be a focus. One project that is planned late winter will be to renovate a few sand traps and tees. Sand trap renovation will start on hole fifteen. Our plan for tees will be to expand smaller ones to accommodate play and improve playing service. With spring around the corner a pre-emergent herbicide will be applied mid to late February. This agronomic application will help prevent summer annual weeds such as crab grass from germinating ensuring quality turf conditions though out the course. 


#### 1st Assistant Golf Professional—Carter Gerwitz


