



Members,

You have helped grow our membership base over the last six years exponentially and we are seeing more and more people get into and return to the game of golf! We know this has put stress on our tee sheet for finding tee times. The staff does a great job with the waiting list and getting you tee times as soon as they become available. We appreciate you letting us know when you need to cancel or will not have a full tee time!

With that said, we are still seeing NO SHOWS daily and we have to combat that. It is not fair for a member to book a tee time and then not show up (with no call) and leave open a tee time that another member could have used.

So, beginning April 1st, we will CANCEL any tee time that is not completely filled out with the names of the players at 2:00 PM the day prior. We feel that this is a better option than charging "no-show" fees like a lot of other clubs charge. Our hopes are that our members will communicate with the golf shop staff as soon as they know that their tee time will not be used, or if they have spots come available.

Starting now, the golf shop will be reaching out to you to verify your tee time for the next day and help add the names onto the tee time. You can help us with this by editing your tee time through the member website and adding the other players yourself.

With the new software that was installed in 2021, you have more control over your tee times than ever before. You can book, cancel, and edit all of the details. If there is something that you come across that you cannot do, please feel free to reach out to the golf shop for assistance by emailing teetimes@wildwoodgreen.com.

Please Note:

- You can begin booking online 15 days ahead of time at 6:00 AM
- Wildwood Green is reserved to members and their accompanied/sponsored guests before noon Friday-Sunday and club holidays.
- We have a waiting list and watch it closely throughout the day. If there is ever a tee time you want but cannot get, reach out to the golf shop to be put on the waiting list.

One of the more common questions I am currently receiving is "when will the fairways green up?" Fairways, tees and rough has been in a dormant state since last November. Green up and recovery in these areas will begin when nighttime temperatures remain above 60 degrees for several days and soil temperatures reach 65 degrees at a 4- inch depth. Averages for March nighttime and soil temperatures are high thirties to low forties. As we advance into spring significant changes occur mid to late May. If you look closely changes have already begun. Greens recover quicker due to mowing height and soil temperatures are warmer because we have covered our greens when extremely cold. 


Monday maintenance begins again on Monday, April 3rd which means the first tee time on Mondays will be 12:00 PM, with the range opening at 11:30 AM!




Announcements
