




General Manager — Jeff Engelhaupt, PGA

Dear members,

Last month we ran a survey regarding the online tee time system and when it should open to allow you to begin booking online tee times. After the results were tallied, we will be staying with the current 6:00 AM time. A results graph is below. As you can see, we had over 220 responses and over 40% of those wanted to stick with the 6:00 AM time.

We have finally finished cart path repair work! Of course, there is a lot of cleanup to do from where their large equipment came in and out of the property. Thank you for being patient with the maintenance team as we work to clean up these areas and work to maintain the regular play areas on a daily basis. Rick plans to lay sod in some areas in the next month and we will see considerable growth on the course as the overnight temperatures continue to rise.

Thank you to everyone who has entered one of Carter's member events! We have seen tremendous participation in these over the past year, averaging nearly 50% more participants than in years past! We have our second major event of the year coming in June, the Club Championship. This is open to all members of the club and we offer both net and gross format options. We are hoping to see record numbers this year so be sure to sign up early!

David Bunn, Outside Operations Manager, has recently put into program a cart cleaning and detailing program. We are trying a few new products on the carts which we are hoping will help keep the carts cleaner longer. As you know, our water pressure at the club is not the best, but the staff does try their best to maintain cleanliness for you. We are hoping the new program put in place makes these our best and cleanest carts to date!



Superintendent — Rick Durham

Spring weather in North Carolina can be a challenge. After a wet, warm winter we were trending for ideal conditions. The spring season is always unpredictable. Cooler temperatures have delayed growth on all warm season grasses. We have completed several agronomic and cultural practices in the month of May. The maintenance team has fertilized and aerified the golf course. This will promote more growth and aid in recovery for playing areas. The irrigation installed over the past two years has maximized these applications. Last year at this time we were in the process of sodding several tees and renovating hole 15 tee. The winter overseed on tee's has helped and we are waiting to see how the transition from rye to Bermuda will progress. So far, we are trending in the correct direction. However, I do see some minimum sod work on tee's to be completed in the coming months. There are also plans to continue renovating smaller high traffic tee's. Most of the sod work will be installed on the cart path areas that were disturbed during paving. The wet damp conditions have prevented us from moving forward with this. Once we begin to have more summer type weather the maintenance team will be able to complete this project. We have been aggressive this spring with vertical mowing and topdressing on greens. There has also been a solid tine aerification completed on greens. Our core aerification schedule is for June 19th and 20th. This agronomic practice is important to relieve compaction and to create pore space to allow water and air to penetrate the soil profile. The healing process should be quick, and the greens will be better than ever. Thank you for all your comments and suggestions and as always, I can be reach at rdurham@wildwoodgreen.com

Here's an example of the Tour Release via 'Folding the Club through the golf ball'. It's a lot easier than you think, take a look!"





Sign Ups Open on May 10th

The Club Championship is open to all members of Wildwood Green. We have several divisions to play in:

Men's Overall Champion – Play comes from blue tees Men's Flight Champion – Play comes from white tees Women's Overall Champion – Play comes from red tees Women's Net Division – Play comes from red tees Senior (60+) Overall Champion – Play comes from gold tees Super Senior (75+) Overall Champion – Play comes from green tees

The Club Championship will be flighted by age and then by "handicap" e.g. what scores you shoot. You may opt into playing a higher flight if you would like (example: a Super Senior wants to play in the Senior division).

We also have a men's net division that will use a handicap however, players in this flight MUST have a GHIN handicap.









Monday Morning Maintenance



As we get out of the colder months, 12:00pm will become the first tee time for Mondays. Monday, April 3rd will be the first Monday with 12:00pm as the first tee time.

Starting on Monday, April 3rd and moving forward, the first tee time on Mondays will be 12:00am until we adjust our hours again due to daylight. The range will open at 11:30am starting on Monday April 3rd.

Aerification Scheduled

Monday June 19th & Tuesday June 20th Only 9 Holes Open Each Day



On Monday, June 19th and Tuesday, June 20th we will have nine holes open each day for aerification. This necessary process will dethatch the green surface and pull the core of the root structure underneath the green's surface. By pulling the core we will allow air and water to penetrate the root structure and strengthen the green surfaces for the remainder of the year.
