Director of Golf – Carter Gerwitz

Dear Members,

Attached is this years survey for determining how we start play Friday - Sunday throughout the Winter. There are three options which I will list out and explain below, please take the time to fill out this quick survey.

Option 1: Single Tee Start (9:00am Start) - This is how we will start Monday-Thursday, with normal tee times going off hole #1 starting at 9:00am. This format allows for approximately 100 people to play a full 18 holes of golf on a winter day and also provides the best pace of play option. Heavily affected by frost delays

Option 2: Double Tee Start (9:00am Start) - This option is similar to the one above, except we will send golfers off hole #1 & hole #10 simultaneously beginning at 9:00am. The benefits of this format is being able to get more golfers out on the course earlier in the day. This options does not allow for quick play and only allows approximately 96 golfers to play a full 18 holes. Heavily affected by frost delays.

Option 3: Shotgun Start (10:00am Start) - This option allows for the maximum amount of 18 hole rounds for members during the winter. We can fit 120 golfers on the course for a 10:00am shotgun. This has been our format the previous two years and I personally believe it works well and benefits the majority of the membership. This option does come with a slow pace of play, average shotgun pace was 4 hours and 18 minutes last year. Being a 10:00am start, this option is not heavily affected by frost delays.

The 10% Discount for prepaying 2024 ended on 9/1/2023. For the month of September, we offered a 7% discount for those who missed the original deadline. October-December, we will offer a 5% discount for those still looking to prepay.

We are continuing to move towards cooler weather and shorter hours. Beginning October 3rd we will be beginning with a 8:00am start for tee times, Tuesday -Sunday. Last bucket will be sold at 6:00pm with a hard shutdown at 6:30pm. As always, we will close two hours earlier on Sundays.

Fall has arrived and the maintenance team at Wildwood Green is busier than ever. The cooler weather is a reminder that it is time for seeding cool season grasses. Last year we established many new fescue areas on the course. These areas are not only aesthetically pleasing but also serve as erosion control. Turf areas that require limited maintenance are ideal. These areas need to be mowed two to three times a year. Last fall we overseeded tees with rye grass to provide a better playing surface during the winter months. It worked so well that we decided to plant it again this fall. It is also time to prepare our warm season turf for the winter months. Mowing heights have been raised on fairways, tees and greens and fall fertilizer has been applied. Pre-emergent herbicides were applied for winter annual weeds. The fall season also ushers in leaves falling and frost delays. I will touch on this next month. As always, I can be reached at rdurham@wildwoodgreen.com


