#### **Dear Members**,

August brought with it a turned page at Wildwood Green. Over the coming weeks/months, you will begin to see some new faces around the property including golf shop staff, cart staff, starters/rangers, food & beverage help, an administrative assistant, and more. Please be patient with myself and the new employees as we aim to assemble a staff dedicating to improving and providing world class service at Wildwood Green. ### Superintendent – Rick Durham

Record heat has been the headline for 2023 summer. Our irrigation system has been pushed over the last two months and has performed well. Hot dry weather can expose weaknesses in irrigation coverage, and we have a few areas that we will be addressing. Overall, I am pleased with the improvements that have been made in this area and we will continue to make more progress. As the summer begins to come to an end, we have several agronomic applications planned for the month of September. First will be a fertilizer application that will cover the entire golf course. Second, we will apply a pre-emergent for winter weeds. This application will help prevent weeds from germinating and growing during the Fall, Winter and Spring months. Last all tees will be overseeded with perennial rye grass. Tees were overseeded last year and turned out to be beneficial for traffic over the Winter and Spring months. Projects will start ramping up again as we begin to slow down on daily maintenance. There are plans to renovate more bunkers and expand the size of smaller tees. 
