Dear Members,

2023 has been a record year for Wildwood Green Golf Club. We've compiled a list of accomplishments including being ranked the #31 top course you can play by the NC Golf Panel, #1 Youth on Course facility in the state by the CGA and HV3 Foundation, and the most ever member/tournament rounds in 2023. Since we converted our greens from bent to bermuda back in 2017, we have seen exponential growth in membership and our operation and benefits have improved greatly. Course conditions have never been better and we were able to complete several capital improvements with more on the way. We have several projects that still need to be completed and we will continue our trend of improvements into the future!

Please know that we could not have accomplished this without your loyalty, support, and patience. All of the staff thank you for being members of the Club and appreciate the time you spend here with us. Know that we try to maintain a lower dues structure while still providing a high-quality service. As you know, operating costs have increased exponentially in the last three years and they are continuing to rise. To help offset the increases, we are implementing a slight increase to membership dues, capital dues, and professional services, effective January 1st, 2024. Facility limitations and further booking restrictions to the public are set to come into effect within the next calendar year. Check page 4 to see the updated dues and professional services for 2024. In other news, we have restructured and modernized our dress code to not only adhere to changes in current golf fashion, but address some current bad habits as well. Superintendent – Rick Durham

You may have noticed that the covers for greens have been placed out on the course. We will be unfolding and marking edges so when the time comes to cover, we will be prepared. A perfect winter for us would be not to cover at all and so far for 2023 we have not covered. The last time covers we deployed was a year ago in December for five days. Many factors are considered when we decide whether to cover greens. Low temperatures are obviously one of the main factors, but you also must consider how long will the temperatures be that low. One or two hours of low temperatures would not be a big concern if the elevated temperature for the day reached the midforties. Moisture levels need to be monitored also. A cold wet event is much better than a cold dry event. We will keep you informed when a weather event is on the way as regards covering. By the end of December there will be twenty-three bunkers that we will have renovated. Weather has cooperated and allowed us to move quicker than expected. A newly renovated bunker will need time to settle and there will be scars of equipment moving. Once we are back in the growing season, I expect a full recovery. 

Students will participate in different kinds of competition according to skill level and age with each student completing rotations which cover every phase of the game. The full week of golf will include individual and group instruction, video analysis, course strategy and management, rules, psychology, club fitting and tournament preparation.

An outstanding staff of PGA professionals, college coaches, and college golfers has been assembled. Their expert instruction is matched only by their dedication to junior golf.

Skill Level and Accommodations

All skill levels (beginner, intermediate, and advanced) are welcome at any golf school week. The student's skill level and age are taken into consideration when making groups. The teacher - student ratio is 5:1 which enables the staff to assist students of all skill levels improve their golf fame. We also understand that siblings and friends are in golf school weeks together and every effort is made to accommodate group requests during group instruction time. Wildwood Green Frost Delay Policy:

When the overnight temperature drops below freezing, there is a potential for a frost delay. If there is frost on the course the Superintendent will let the Golf Shop know what the revised starting time for the day will be as quickly as

possible, and we will inform you of any updates via E-Communication.

Once the Superintendent gives the Golf Shop the "all clear" to begin play, we will implement a forward shotgun for all play at and before the new starting time. We have a 45-minute minimum notification time, so if we get the goahead to open the course at 9:00am, the shotgun will begin at 9:45am to allow golfers time to get to the course.

Things to Keep in Mind:

• If frost on the course is ignored and regular play commences it will cause damage to the playing surface and make the grass susceptible to disease and weeds.

• Frost Delays also apply to the practice greens. We don't want to damage those!

Wildwood Green Dress Code



Based off of CGA/USGA Dress Code Policy

This dress code must be followed at all times at Wildwood Green Golf Club. This means on all practice greens (behind range and behind clubhouse), on the driving range, and on the golf course

Clothing Requirements:

- Collared Shirts, Mock Turtle Necks, Plain Golf Shirts, Golf Appropriate Athletic Shirts, Golf Appropriate Outerwear
- All shirts MUST have sleeves and collars or a collar band
- Appropriate length bottoms (shorts, skorts, skirts, etc.)
- Compression clothing must be appropriate length and covered (leggings, compression shirts, etc.)
- It is preferred for shirts to be tucked in while playing golf

Restricted Clothing:

- Tee Shirts (Allowed for ages 16-under)
- Any sort of denim (Jeans, Jean jackets, Shorts, etc.)
- Clothing cannot be torn or frayed, intentional or not
- Cargo shorts/Pants
- NO athletic shorts/sweatpants/swimsuits
- NO sports bras
- Metal spikes are prohibited
- Shirts must cover stomach and go down to waist length
- NO T-shirts with writing or imagery
