Fairways, tees, and rough will be fertilized. Aerification will **Rick Durham** begin in these areas to assist with reducing compaction and creating healthier turf. Watering schedules have already been set and are being utilized nightly. Greens top dressing began early on in April, and we are already seeing benefits. This will continue weekly through the growing season. A core aerification for greens has been scheduled later in June. Our pump station, which is the heart of the irrigation system, will be serviced this month. This will be vital to ensure we can irrigate through the growing season. We have plans to renovate seventeen tee and will begin once we are in

Each player is awarded points for their score on each hole as follows: Net eagle = 4 pts. Net Birdie = 3 pts. Net Par = 2pts. Net Bogey = 1 pt. The team with the most points wins.






Donna Strickland Chair of the Wildflowers Invitational






