Wildwood will donate \$1 for every round of golf played at our course in May. We will also be accepting additional donations from members and guests.

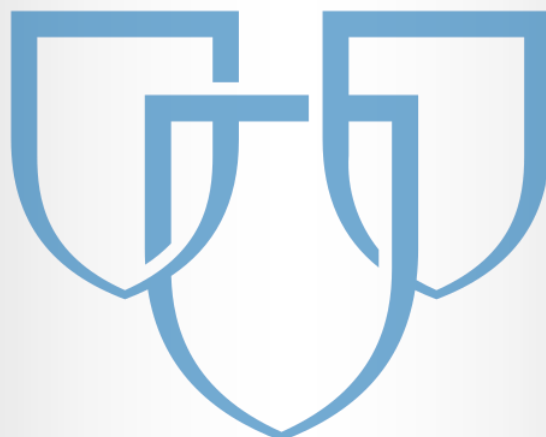

# Golf Course

We are ahead of where we were last year at this time with course conditions. Warmer weather is beginning to be more consistent and has played a role in this. Agronomically, we have several applications planned for the month of May.



**Superintendent-**

Fairways, tees, and rough will be fertilized. Aerification will begin in these areas to assist with reducing compaction and creating healthier turf. Watering schedules have already been set and are being utilized nightly. Greens top dressing began early on in April, and we are already seeing benefits. This will continue weekly through the growing season. A core aerification for greens has been scheduled later in June. Our pump station, which is the heart of the irrigation system, will be serviced this month. This will be vital to ensure we can irrigate through the growing season. We have plans to renovate seventeen tee and will begin once we are in June. 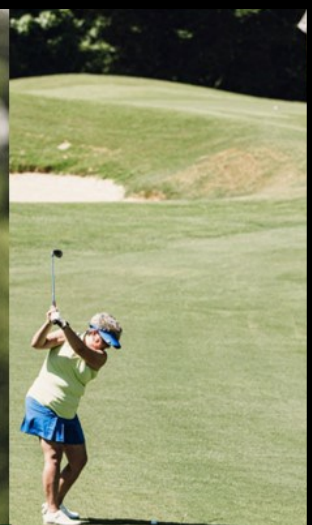
