Aerification Scheduled

Monday June 16th & Tuesday June 17th

Only 9 Holes Open Each Day



On Monday, June 16th and Tuesday, June 17th we will have nine holes open each day for aerification. This necessary process will dethatch the green surface and pull the core of the root structure underneath the green's surface. By pulling the core we will allow air and water to penetrate the root structure and strengthen the green surfaces for the remainder of the year.

Golf Course

May brought an interesting mix of conditions, swinging between dry and wet with little in between. Fortunately, our course fertilizer application landed during a dry week, followed by plenty of rain to help it take effect.

Cooler temperatures have held back growth across all Bermuda, but I expect June to turn that around. We're in a good position heading into the heat and humidity. Along with fertilization, we've aerified all fairways and tees. I hope we can repeat this cultural practice in June to further promote healthy growth.

Greens aerification is scheduled for this month. We're planning a more aggressive approach this year, pulling a larger core to reduce compaction and support healthier turf. Our weekly maintenance program has paid off so far, and I foresee even more improvement as the season continues.

June will be a busy month for the maintenance team. In addition to aerification, we plan to backfill damaged areas with topsoil and sod—many of these spots were affected by past projects. Looking ahead, we also have tree work to complete and plan to expand several tees.

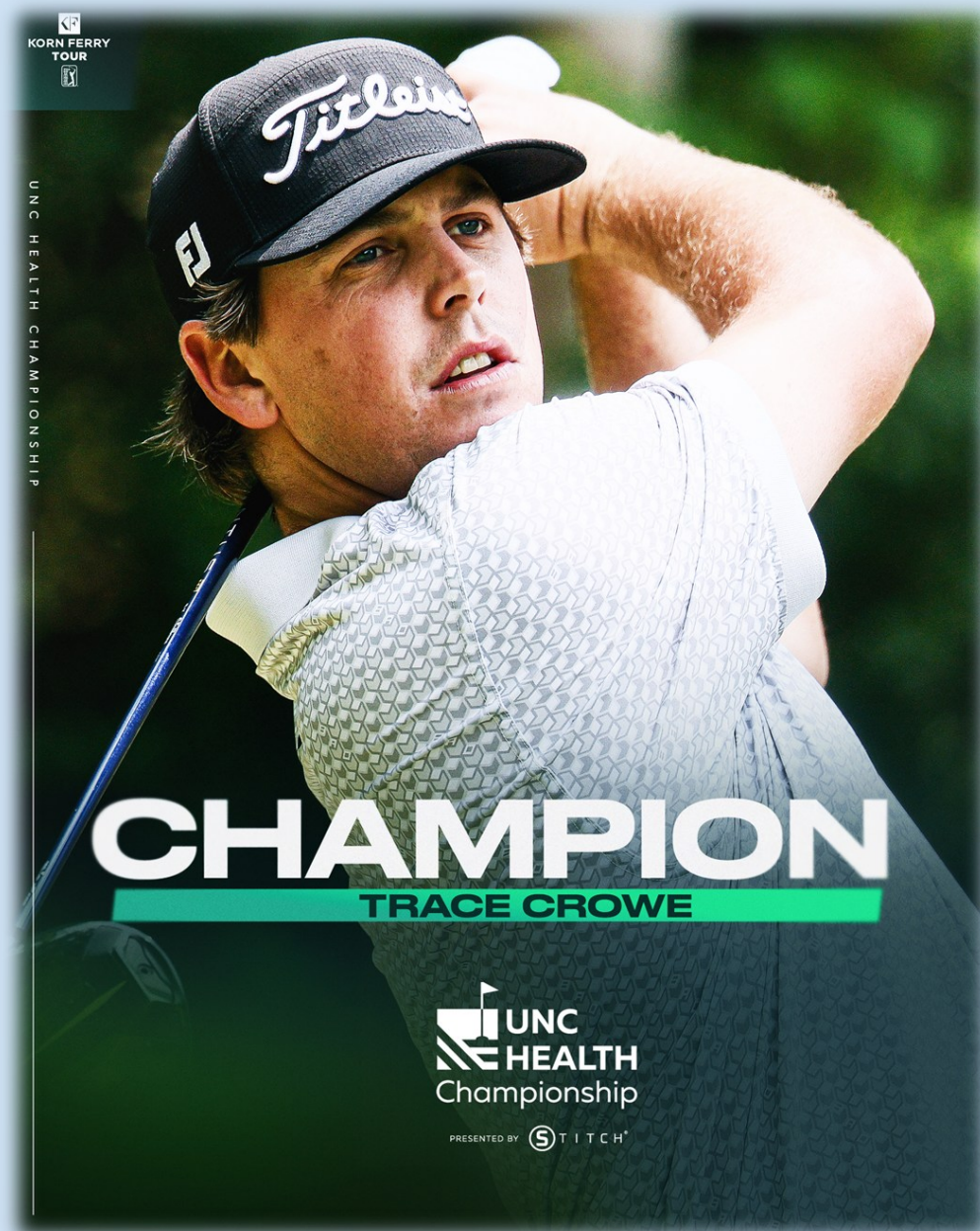
