Dear Members,

As we near the end of summer we are excited to announce our 2026 prepayment program! This program is an integral part of our planning process for the upcoming year. It allows us to make improvements to the facility in the off season and helps us plan and prepare for the following calendar year. We hope that you will be able to take advantage of this program and save money on your 2026 dues and services! Prepayment guarantees your rate for the upcoming season. If there is an increase in membership dues in 2026 you will not be assessed the difference if you have prepaid for the year. Included in this packet is an updated membership rates page for your reference.

Special note for GHIN: In 2026 we will require members who want to participate in our events (tournaments & WGGC leagues) to keep their GHIN through Wildwood. If you do not play in our events or leagues you are not required to keep your handicap through us. Since we are going to be require this for our tournaments & leagues we will be reducing our price from \$55 to \$45. This price change now matches the lowest in the State, including Carolina e-club.

Why not take advantage of this opportunity to **SAVE** money on your 2026 dues and professional services? Not only does prepaying lock in your dues and service rate for the coming year, but it also saves you money! The discount offered for prepaying is 10% off. By prepaying your membership dues, you can also prepay for your services and receive the same prepayment discount (excluding GHIN handicap)! The 10% discount is for those members who prepay **prior to September 1st!**

Course Conditions Update

Mother Nature has once again had a major impact on the course. Abundant rainfall combined with extreme heat and humidity has caused the turf to flourish—but not without challenges.

The heavy precipitation has made the greens puffy, requiring scalping and an increased frequency of topdressing. These cultural practices help reduce grain and keep the surfaces firm, fast, and smooth.

Rainfall has also forced us to tighten cart control. We've added ropes and stakes in several areas, with more to come. "Cart path only" days aren't easy decisions, but they're necessary. Wet soils compact easily—not just from tracks, but from pressure—making it harder for turf to grow and recover.

As mentioned in the last newsletter, several trees were struck by lightning. We'll begin removing those, along with a few additional ones, in the coming month.

Our irrigation system has also had issues: a six-inch main line blew out, and several control clocks were damaged by lightning.

This summer has been a challenge, and I appreciate your continued support through it all. As always, feel free to reach out to me at

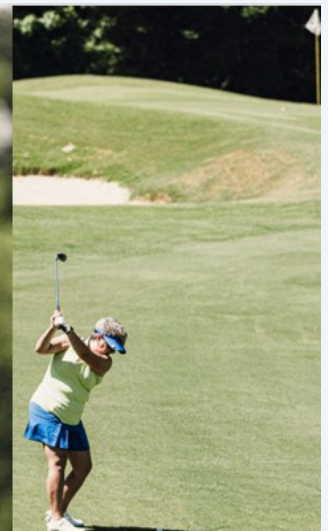
