

Wildwood Green's modern identity was shaped in 1986 under the stewardship of Roger and Sandy Watson and refined through a comprehensive redesign in 1996 by respected architect John LaFoy. Known for creating courses that reward thoughtful shot-making, LaFoy's regional work includes Devils Ridge Golf Club, The Neuse Golf Club, North Ridge Country Club, and Carolina Country Club.

Built by Landscapes Unlimited, a nine-time national honoree, the course has continued to evolve with intention. Champion Bermudagrass greens installed in 2017—consistently regarded among the finest in the Triangle—paired with recent cart path and bunker renovations, deliver polished, dependable playing conditions that reflect a commitment to quality found at the triangle's most respected clubs.

Signature Tournaments

- **Member-Member**

Our spring and fall Member-Member tournaments are among the most anticipated events of the year. These two-day competitions feature 50-60 two-person teams, flighted by handicap to ensure competitive balance. Flight winners advance to an exciting overall playoff that always delivers memorable moments.

- **Member-Guest**

The most anticipated event on the Wildwood Green calendar. Our Member-Guest is designed to deliver exceptional value and one of the most action-packed weekends of the year. Sixty two-person teams compete in a flighted, round-robin match play format, playing 45 holes over two unforgettable days.

- **Club Championship**

The most prestigious title at Wildwood Green. The Club Championship is a two-day stroke play competition featuring the club's top golfers. The event is flighted first by age and then by handicap, and each year produces outstanding competition and championship-level scores.

- **Watson Cup**

Once a year, Wildwood Green hosts a Ryder Cup-style match play event in honor of tradition and competition. The Watson Cup is a 36-hole event spanning two days and includes four different match formats and four separate 9-hole competitions.

Leagues & Member Groups

- **WildFlowers (Women's Golf Association)**

WildFlowers play a scheduled 18-hole format every Tuesday morning from March through October. Additional tee times are available on Thursdays for members looking to get extra rounds in during the week.

- **WildOats (50+ Men's Group)**

Open to male members age 50 and older, WildOats meet on Tuesdays and Thursdays year-round. Starting times adjust seasonally to maximize playability.

- **Gaggle**

The Gaggle is a men's member group open to members and accompanied guests. Play occurs Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays year-round, typically beginning with 10:00 AM tee times.

- **MGA (Men's Golf Association)**

Running from May through September, the MGA meets Monday evenings with tee times beginning around 5:30 PM. Players compete in nine-hole match play.

- **Medalist Game**

Held once per month on Sunday mornings, the Medalist Game is a gross-only competition designed for lower-handicap golfers seeking a true competitive test. Tee times are assigned by the golf shop, and normal play is not disrupted.

- **Member-Run Groups**

Wildwood Green features a variety of member-run groups throughout the week for both men and women. The golf shop is happy to connect members with any group of interest.




