Director of Golf Update

As we move through the winter season, I want to take a moment to clearly explain why we ask for advance check-in for our Friday, Saturday, and Sunday 10:00 AM shotgun starts—and why your participation in this process is critical to the smooth operation of the club.

The purpose of winter shotgun starts is simple: to allow as many members as possible to play 18 holes during limited daylight. To make this work, we send preliminary starting holes the day prior at 2:00 PM and ask members to check in via email in advance.

Earlier this winter, participation in advance check-in was extremely low. For example, on **12/21/2025**:

- 114 total players participated
- Only 7 players checked in in advance
- 107 players required in-person check-in between opening and 10:00 AM

While approximately 40 players emailed the morning of play between 8:30–10:00 AM, this largely defeats the purpose of advance check-in. By that time, our staff is already assisting members in person, staging carts and bags, answering phones, handling payments, and managing the many tasks required to start the shotgun on time.

That said, I want to sincerely thank those members who have made an effort to check in ahead of time since December 21st. We have seen improvement, and it has made a noticeable difference for our staff and the overall flow of the morning. Your cooperation has not gone unnoticed and is greatly appreciated.

Moving forward, I strongly encourage all members playing in winter shotgun starts to check in the day before when the email is sent, whenever you are able to do so. We fully understand that weather forecasts, frost delays, or changing conditions may make early check-in difficult on certain days, and that is completely reasonable. When conditions allow, we ask that you take a moment to check in via email to teetimes@wildwoodgreen.com once the shotgun sheet is published.

This is a small action that has a very large impact on our ability to provide the level and pace of service our members expect. We appreciate your continued understanding, cooperation, and support—especially during these busy winter shotgun days.

Course Conditions Update

As we move into 2026, North Carolina weather remains as unpredictable as ever. Over the past few weeks, temperatures have swung from the low 20s to the 70s, with little to no rainfall. Since greens covers have been out, we've only needed to cover once so far. Extended cold combined with dry conditions isn't ideal for overall turf health, so we closely monitor temperatures and forecasts. Our decisions are based on how long severe cold is expected to last, current moisture levels, and daytime high temperatures. Hopefully, we'll continue to enjoy good golfing weather without needing to cover the greens.

This time of year also allows us to focus on our maintenance fleet. Our team has been busy servicing, sharpening, and preparing equipment for the upcoming season. It may feel odd to mention summer wear and tear during cool weather, but the heat can be tough on equipment, and preparation now makes a big difference later.

Leaves have been a constant challenge throughout the fall and winter, but that's now largely under control as we head into the new year. Over the next few months, you'll see the maintenance team working on bunker repairs, adding mulch, and addressing a few minor irrigation issues. Spring will be here before you know it.

For those unfamiliar with Interclub, it is a competitive event where Wildwood Green forms a team to compete against other clubs in the Carolinas. With a strong history of success and as reigning Men's Regular Champions, we are confident in bringing home another trophy or two in 2026! Ensure your spot by registering before February 15th. Payment is required upon registration, which includes a Foot-Joy team shirt.

The CGA Interclub is happy to introduce **TWO NEW** divisions!

- *Men's Gross Scoring Only Division*
- *Women's Division*



Men's Gross Division details

- 4 man teams (8 total competing players)
- Minimum age of 18 years old
- Four-ball match play. 1 point per hole. 2 point bonus for a win, or 1 point for a tie. 40 total points up for grabs with 20.5 points winning the Club vs Club match
- Gross scoring only (no handicaps)
- Teams can pair players to their choosing, but pairings must be set 24-hours prior to the match
- All players will play from the same tee. Teams MUST play from a rated set of tees that is as close as possible to 6,400 yards
- 6 Regular Season matches (3 home & 3 away). Regular Season is March 2 - July 26. Playoffs begin August 1.

Women's Division details

- 4 player teams (8 total competing players)
- Minimum 18 years old or older
- Four-Ball match play. 1 point per hole. 2 point bonus for a win, or 1 point for a tie. 40 total points up for grabs with 20.5 points winning the Club vs Club match.
- Pairings are based on each player's 12-month Low Handicap Index™ (Low H.I.) and are set in Low to High, handicap index order - Handicaps automatically updated each Monday. Players compete to 85% of the difference in the Unrounded Course Handicaps from the player with the lowest Playing Handicap in each foursome, based on their Low H.I.. One player in each foursome plays at scratch.
- There is no maximum Low H.I. to compete.
- All players will play from the same tee. Teams MUST play from a rated set of tees that is between 4,700 - 5,300 yards.
- 6 Regular Season matches (3 home & 3 away). Regular Season is March 2 - July 26. The Men's Regular, Men's Senior, and Men's Super Senior all remain the same format and structure for 2026.

Entry Fee:

\$75 for one men's team, \$65 for the women's team, \$25 for each additional men's team (includes a team Foot-Joy shirt). Members may compete for all teams they are eligible for.

Men's Regular (18+)

Men's Senior (55+)

Men's Super Senior (65+)

Women's Regular (18+)

Men's Gross (18+)

Eligibility Requirements:

- Payment must be made at the time of registration
- Must be listed on the club's GHIN handicap roster
- Must be in good standing with the club
- Must have at least 10 posted scores within the last 12 months
- Men's Regular League: Must have a 12-month low index of 18.4 or lower (no index limit for Senior League)
- Regular Leagues: Must be at least 18 years of age
- Senior League: Must be 55 years or older
- Super Senior League: Must be 65 years or older
- The regular season runs from March through July, with the postseason beginning in August and ending in November.



2026 Dues and Rates Update

Effective January 1st, 2026, membership dues and services will reflect a modest 5% adjustment, with capital dues now incorporated directly into your monthly billing for easier viewing and simplified accounting. This change does not alter the goals or funding of our capital improvement projects. Those allocations will continue on the backend as always. Cart fees will remain unchanged, as our new fleet has already arrived and is performing well. For members who participate in club-run events or leagues, please remember that maintaining your GHIN Handicap through Wildwood Green is required, and the annual GHIN fee for 2026 will be \$45 (\$10 decrease from 2025). Our commitment remains to keep Wildwood Green one of the best values in the Triangle while continuing to reinvest in your experience both on and off the course. Public rates will see an increase as well in 2026. Please refer to the next two pages for both 2026 membership dues and greens fee rates.
