

BY-LAWS OF THE WILDFLOWERS LADIES GOLF ASSOCIATION

February 27, 2026

ARTICLE 1: NAME — The name of the women’s golf association at Wildwood Green Golf Club shall be the “Wildflowers”. The Wildflowers shall be organized as a golf and social organization composed of women golfers.

ARTICLE 2: PURPOSE: The purpose of this organization shall be to promote friendly competition and to *promote* fellowship among golfers playing at Wildwood Green Golf Club.

ARTICLE 3: MEMBERSHIP — Membership in the Wildflowers is open to all women golfers 18 years of age or older with an established handicap. *A player needs a handicap index of 40 or lower to join the league.*

ARTICLE 4: CALENDAR Playing season shall begin the first Tuesday of March and end the last Tuesday of October.

ARTICLE 5: DUES — Dues for membership in the Wildflowers shall be proposed by the Board and voted on by the membership at the kick-off meeting each year. Dues are payable at the first meeting of the year and considered past due if not paid by March 30. *Prospective members must pay current dues after 3 playdates during the Wildflowers year.-Membership is annual from March 1 through February 28 of the following year.* Membership dues shall be used for expenses approved by the Wildflowers membership.

ARTICLE 6: MEETINGS: General membership meetings shall be held at various times during the golf season as determined necessary by the officers. At general membership meetings, a simple majority of those present and voting may change and pass issues.

ARTICLE 7: VOTING — Any questions or changes that are brought to a vote shall be decided by a simple majority of the members present at a “called” meeting or via email ballot.

ARTICLE 8: ELECTION OF OFFICERS — A slate of officers shall be presented and voted on by the membership at the year-end meeting/luncheon.

ARTICLE 9: DUTIES OF OFFICERS

Section 1 - **PRESIDENT**: The president shall preside at all meetings, discharge all other duties of office, and shall be a member ex officio of all committees. The President shall ~~also~~ serve as liaison to the Wildwood Green Golf Club. The President must be a member of Wildwood Green Golf Club.

Section 2 - **VICE PRESIDENT**: The Vice President shall assist the President and perform all duties in the President's absence. The President and Vice President will share responsibility for all weekly games. The Vice President must be a member of Wildwood Green Golf Club.

Section 3- TREASURER LIAISON: The Treasurer Liaison shall oversee the financial affairs of the Wildflowers with the Wildwood Green Golf Club Accountant. The Treasurer Liaison should ensure proper records are kept and that effective financial procedures are in place. The Treasurer Liaison & President will receive a monthly report. The Treasurer Liaison will report on the economic health of the Wildflowers. The Treasurer Liaison shall be responsible for the Wildflowers' Directory and sending each member a copy, updating the file as needed during the season.

Section 4 - **SECRETARY**: The Secretary shall record the minutes of the Wildflowers meetings and give a copy to the President. The Secretary shall ~~also~~ send a digital copy of the minutes of the previous Wildflowers meeting to all members at least three days before the next meeting at which they will be approved.

Section 5 - **RINGER CLUB CHAIR**: The Ringer Club gives players the chance to see how their game has improved over the season by recording their BEST score for each hole throughout the season. The Ringer Chair will create ringer cards for all league members who have joined the Ringer Club. The Cards will include the player's name and starting handicap. It is the PLAYER's responsibility to update their card after play on league day. At the end of the year, the Ringer Chair will determine flights and winners, and distribute winnings, showing how each of the Ringer Club members has improved compared to their starting handicap.

Section 6- BIRDIE & CHIP-IN CHAIR: The Birdie & Chip-In Chair is responsible for keeping and compiling stats on Birdies and Chip-Ins throughout the season. A compilation of Birdies and Chip-Ins shall be submitted to the President at the end of the Wildflowers' current season for awards.

Section 7 - **NEWSLETTER CHAIR:** The Newsletter Chair will be responsible for producing a monthly newsletter, that reflects the previous month's achievements, and upcoming events and news. This newsletter will be provided electronically to all Wildflower members and to the club's General Manager for printing and posting in the clubhouse.

Section 8- INVITATIONAL LIAISON: Invitational Liaison will collaborate with the Wildwood Green Golf Tournament Director to support participant solicitation, the event decorations, and the coordination of volunteers

ARTICLE 10: OFFICER SUCCESSION — The President of the current year shall succeed as the Past President for the following year. The Vice President shall succeed as President for the following year.

ARTICLE 11: COMMITTEES — Any Chairperson may, at her discretion, appoint a committee to assist her.

ARTICLE 12: HANDICAPS — Official USGA handicaps for Wildflowers members shall be required before they can enter any tournament /event sponsored by the Wildflowers.

ARTICLE 13: HOLE-IN-ONE CLUB — At the start of each season, players may contribute to the Hole-In-One club. To be eligible to collect the balance of the fund, they must score a hole-in-one on a Tuesday of the league season, March 1 through October 31.

- Hole-In-One funds will be distributed at the end of the season, *March 1 through October 31*, divided equally between all *players who* scored a Hole-In-One during league play.
- If no player scores a Hole-In-One during the season, the balance is held over for the next season. League players will have to recontribute at the start of each season.
- If the balance for the Hole-In-One fund reaches \$400, current members of the Hole-In-One Club will be grandfathered into the Club. New members to the league are welcome to join the club. Once a Hole-In-One is scored, the fund resets, and all members are welcome to rejoin the club.

ARTICLE 14: AMENDMENTS — Amendments or additions to these By-Laws may be made by a 2/3 vote of the members. Notification to the membership shall be made within 30 days before the date scheduled for such amendments or additions to become effective.
