Director of Golf Update

Member Course Etiquette & Protecting Your Golf Course

As we head into the heart of the season and prepare for prime growing conditions, the care of our golf course is truly a shared responsibility. The small things every golfer does each round have a major impact on course conditioning, playability, and the member experience.

Please remember to:

- Fill your divots on tee boxes and in the fairways with the sand provided. This allows turf to recover quickly and keeps surfaces level for everyone.
- Repair your ball marks and at least one additional mark on every green. An unrepaired mark can take weeks to heal, while a properly fixed one recovers in just a few days.
- Be mindful of traffic patterns, especially in entry and exit areas around greens and in low or wet spots.

A growing concern for turf health is pushcart traffic in sensitive areas. While push carts are an excellent walking option, they place significant weight on a very small footprint, particularly electric push carts and can cause just as much damage as a riding cart when used in wet conditions or around green-side collars.

If we continue to see wear and thinning turf in these areas, we may need to implement push-cart–path-only restrictions on wet days, similar to our riding cart policy. This is not something we want to do, but it may become necessary to protect the surfaces we all enjoy.

Your awareness and daily habits directly influence:

- Turf recovery and overall course conditions
- Pace of play and playability
- Long-term maintenance costs and capital preservation

Thank you for taking pride in your golf course and for doing your part each round. Small actions by every member make a huge difference.

Course Conditions Update

January and February certainly didn't give us much of a break. Between the cold temperatures and frequent wet weather, it has not been ideal golfing conditions. Like many of you, we are more than ready to turn the page to spring. Hopefully March brings milder days and more opportunities to get out on the course.

Even with the challenging weather, our maintenance team has stayed busy. We've successfully applied pre-emergent herbicide to half of the course and plan to complete the remaining application by the first of March, weather permitting. This treatment is an important step in preventing summer annual weeds from germinating later in the season. Getting ahead of those issues now helps us maintain healthier turf and better playing conditions throughout the summer.

We're also beginning to see encouraging signs on the greens. They have started to wake up after a long, cold winter, which is a positive sign for the season ahead. As soil temperatures continue to rise, growth will gradually increase. Some areas may be slower to respond than others, particularly spots that experienced heavier stress during the winter months. That's normal this time of year, and we'll continue to monitor and adjust our approach as needed.

The rest of the course is still somewhat of a question mark. Early spring always reveals how well different areas handled winter conditions. Over the next several weeks, we'll have a clearer picture and can address any thin or damaged areas as growth picks up.

In the meantime, we've been focusing on projects that improve the overall look and playability of the course. Our team has been spreading fresh mulch and working on landscaping around key areas to enhance appearance and definition. We have also removed a few trees that were either unhealthy or impacting turf quality. Tree removal improves sunlight and air circulation, both of which are critical for strong turf growth.

Sand trap maintenance is another priority this spring. We plan to complete much-needed work to ensure better drainage, consistent sand depth, and improved playing conditions. Well-maintained bunkers not only look better but also provide a fair and predictable experience for golfers.

Spring is right around the corner, and with it comes longer days, greener fairways, and more time on the course. We appreciate your patience during the off-season and through periods of unfavorable weather. Your comments and suggestions are always welcome and help us continue to improve.

Ryan Gerard Featured on Golf Channel



Each team will play Front 9, Back 9, and Overall matches against every other team in the field. Separate leaderboards will be kept for each segment, and the combined total of all three will determine final standings and payouts.

We are excited to introduce a new monthly game that will be hosted on the same day as Skins day each month.

There are many variations of SWAT formats—gross or net scoring, teams of two or four, counting one or multiple balls—which allows clubs to tailor the competition to their membership. Wildwood Green will use the same format as our member-member for our monthly SWAT games (Count 1 Net & 1 Gross). Monthly SWATs will be individual sign-ups and teams will be made via Golf Genius.

New Practice Facility Amenity

We are excited to introduce a new practice feature on the driving range — custom Wildwood Green alignment sticks are now available at select bag racks for member use. These sticks are a great tool for improving aim, setup, and overall practice efficiency, and we hope they help everyone practice with more purpose and consistency.

A few important notes:


- Alignment sticks are for use on the driving range only
- Please return them to the rack when you finish practicing
- They are not to be removed from the range

This will begin as a small-scale rollout at a few stations, with plans to expand across the entire range once all custom sets arrive and we evaluate how the program is working. Our starters will place the sticks out each morning and collect them each evening as part of their daily setup. Because of this, those practicing very early in the morning or later in the evening may occasionally find that the sticks have not yet been set out or have already been put away.

As with all of our practice amenities, this will work best when everyone helps take care of them so the entire membership can benefit.

For wedges and putters, we move to Wildwood's short game area, bunker, and putting green, focusing on scoring shots that truly save strokes on and around the greens.


