Course Conditions Update

This time of year in North Carolina, the weather is always unpredictable. One day you're wearing three layers, and the next you're in shorts. As we move into the season, weather becomes even more important.

As you've probably seen in recent reports, we are currently in a drought. Some days it may not feel that way, especially when we're cart path only, but as the Bermuda grass begins to wake up, the dry conditions will become more noticeable. We're starting to run our irrigation system more regularly, as water is essential for green-up as temperatures rise.

So far, I don't see anything too concerning following the cold winter we experienced. Some fairways are a bit slow in areas, but we won't know the full picture until temperatures continue to warm.

April also marks the start of Maintenance Mondays. During this time, we'll be doing light sanding on the greens along with vertical mowing. The good news is that our greens came through the winter in great shape, with no issues. We've even seen some unexpected growth spurts, which is unusual for this time of year. These maintenance practices will help us maintain consistent putting surfaces throughout the season.

We also have a few projects planned:

- Adding steps on Hole 14 (landscaping to follow)
- Renovating and expanding the tee box on Hole 17

We hope to begin these soon.

Eleven adults and juniors have already advanced to a new distance tee including Jacob Holding advancing to 1800 yards after numerous attempts to score 36 or better from 1350 yards. Linda Spellman took advantage of a hole in one on number 4 from 120 yards with her 5 wood to advance to the 1800 yard distance again having showed the determination to keep trying from 1350 yards.



Linda becomes our first female golfer to play from the 1800 yard distance! Jade and June Joiner both have advanced to 900 yards passing the 450 yard barrier the same day. Each team will play Front 9, Back 9, and Overall matches against every other team in the field. Separate leaderboards will be kept for each segment, and the combined total of all three will determine final standings and payouts.

We are excited to introduce a new monthly game that will be hosted on the same day as Skins day each month.

There are many variations of SWAT formats—gross or net scoring, teams of two or four, counting one or multiple balls—which allows clubs to tailor the competition to their membership. Wildwood Green will use the same format as our member-member for our monthly SWAT games (Count 1 Net & 1 Gross). Monthly SWATs will be individual sign-ups and teams will be made via Golf Genius.

Handicap Allowance: 100%

Format SWAT: Count 1 Net and 1 Gross (cant be the same ball)
