Director of Golf Update

New Flags

Members,

You'll notice a change on the greens out on the course. We will be transitioning to a single-color flagstick and flag across all 18 holes, moving away from the traditional red (front), white (middle), and yellow (back) system. As part of this update, our new flags will feature a split yellow and green design with our three-tree logo, giving the course a more modern and consistent look.

This change is part of our ongoing effort to modernize the presentation of the golf course while continuing to provide the best possible experience for all.

There are several key benefits to this transition:

Improved Course Conditioning

Our maintenance team will no longer be locked into a front, middle, back rotation. This allows hole locations to be selected in the best possible position while providing more options than a traditional rotation.

More Efficient Maintenance Operations

Staff can now cut a new cup and leave the existing flagstick in place, eliminating the need to move flags between holes daily. That time is redirected into higher-impact work that improves overall course conditions.

Better Distribution of Traffic & Wear

Increased flexibility in hole locations helps spread foot traffic more evenly, reducing stress on commonly used areas of the greens.

Pace of Play Benefits

Removing the need to identify flag color simplifies decision-making. Instead of confirming front, middle, or back and adjusting yardage, players can rely directly on rangefinders and GPS for exact distances. It becomes more of a "see it, hit it" mentality rather than overthinking yardages. And truthfully, if we all hit it the exact distance and line every time, we'd be out on Tour. In addition, there are very few shots on the property where you can't visually identify the hole location, which helps keep things moving.

Aligned with the Modern Game with a Cleaner Look

This approach has become the norm at most clubs today. With widespread use of rangefinders, GPS in carts, and mobile apps, the traditional color system is no longer necessary for the majority of players. A single flag design creates a more uniform and streamlined appearance across the course, a subtle but meaningful upgrade to overall presentation.

Member Waitlist

We know how tough it can be to secure a tee time, especially during peak hours, but my team and I are here to help. If you're not seeing availability online, don't give up. Call or email the golf shop and get on the waitlist. Over the past two years, the member waitlist has had a 90% success rate, so there's a very good chance we can get you where you want to be.

A quick tip from me. If you're only checking online and not getting results, you're missing out. The waitlist is one of the most effective tools we have, but we can't help you if we don't know you're looking.

Pace of Play- It Takes All of Us

At Wildwood Green, our target pace of play is 4 hours and 16 minutes. That number isn't random. It's based on what the golf course is rated for and what we believe creates the best experience for everyone on the property.

Over the past couple of years, we've made real progress. What used to average closer to 4 hours 50 minutes is now trending much closer to our goal. That doesn't happen by accident. It's a combination of operational changes, better tools, and cooperation from our membership and guests.

What We're Doing

We continue to invest time and resources into improving pace of play across the board.

Our GPS system in the carts provides real-time pace feedback and helps identify where slowdowns are happening. We're also using tee sheet data and daily pace reports to get a clearer picture of the flow of play, rather than just reacting to gaps on the golf course.

Our ranger team is out there with a purpose. Their role is not just to "tell groups to speed up," but to understand what's actually causing delays and help move things along in a productive way. In some situations, that may mean asking a group to pick up pace. In others, it may mean having a group skip a hole to close a gap and get the course back in position.

We also continue to manage the tee sheet carefully. Spacing, pairing, and limiting outside events are all part of keeping the course flowing the way it should.

What You Can Do

At the end of the day, pace of play is a shared responsibility. It only takes one or two groups out of position to impact everyone behind them.

Here are a few simple ways every group can help:

Play Ready Golf

Be ready to hit when it's your turn. If you're prepared and it's safe, go ahead and play. Honors is great in tournaments, but day-to-day play should be about efficiency.

Keep Up with the Group in Front of You

Your position on the course is determined by the group ahead, not the group behind. If you have open space in front of you, you're out of position.

Limit Time Searching for Golf Balls

We all want to find our ball, but be mindful of time. If it's not found quickly, move on and keep play moving.

Be Efficient on the Greens

Read your putt while others are putting. Be ready when it's your turn. Mark, clean, and line up your ball in advance when possible.

Play the Right Tees

Playing from a tee that matches your ability helps keep the game enjoyable and keeps the pace moving for your group and others.

Cart Awareness

Drop a player off with a few clubs and move to your ball. Don't wait together if you don't have to.

Let Faster Groups Play Through

If your group is holding up play and there's an opening ahead of you, please allow faster groups to play through. It's one of the simplest and most effective ways to keep the course moving and is a basic part of golf etiquette.

A Final Thought

We all come out here to enjoy the game, and pace of play plays a big role in that experience. When the course is flowing, rounds feel better, expectations are met, and everyone has a more enjoyable day.

We will continue to do our part operationally, and we appreciate your help in doing yours. When everyone is working together, the difference is noticeable.

New Bunker Rakes

We are transitioning from our traditional bunker rakes to slightly different style called a "chief" bunker rake (see attached photo). The rakes are equipped with a slightly longer handle as well as a wider rake head with shallower teeth. These rakes are designed specifically for our softer, finer sand and should help us maintain smoother, more consistent bunker conditions throughout the day. What we ask from you: The objective is simple: leave the bunker as smooth as possible. Rake your footprints, your shot, and anything else you disturb. No piles, no depressions, no uneven areas.

Entering & Exiting

- Always enter and exit from the lowest point of the bunker.
- Do not jump in or climb steep faces, this damages turfed bunker edges and causes sand to shift inside the bunker.

Raking Technique (See Video [HERE](#))

- Use a light, back-and-forth motion to smooth the sand with long, smooth strokes.
- Rake toward the center first, then lightly feather it back out to create a uniform surface.
- Avoid pulling sand up onto the grass or piling it along the edges.

Around the Edges

- Be mindful not to drag sand out of the bunker, this leads to poor turf conditions and unclear bunker edges as well as exposing the bunker liner at times.

Finishing Up

- Knock sand off your shoes before stepping onto the green.
- Place the rake inside the bunker, on a flat spot near the edge, with the head pointing toward the green / direction of play.

Why This Matters

Our maintenance team works hard every morning to have bunkers in excellent condition. After that, it's in our hands. With many of my rounds coming in the late afternoon, I often see bunkers go from near-perfect in the morning to looking like a crowded beach by 4–5 PM, footprints everywhere, unraked areas, and inconsistent lies. That's something we as golfers can easily fix with a little extra care. Please take the extra 20–30 seconds to rake properly, and don't hesitate to hold your playing partners accountable as well. Doing this right is one of the simplest ways to take care of the golf course and improve the experience for everyone. We appreciate your help in continuing to raise the standard at Wildwood Green.

Course Conditions Update

As many of you have already noticed, we are currently dealing with significant drought conditions. You can see the impact just by looking at the irrigation ponds, which are noticeably lower than usual for this time of year.

To give some perspective, last summer our highest monthly water usage was in August, when we used around 600,000 gallons. This year, in just the month of April, we've already used slightly over 700,000 gallons. That's a substantial increase, and it reflects just how dry the conditions have been.

The combination of low humidity, high temperatures, and lack of rainfall has made it challenging to keep the course looking its best. While our water supply is still adequate for now, it's something we are monitoring closely and managing carefully. Water will be especially important as we move into upcoming fertilizer applications and aerification, so conservation and efficiency are key priorities.

Once we return to a more typical weather pattern, particularly with warmer nighttime temperatures and some consistent rainfall, we expect the course conditions to improve and begin to flourish again. Until then, we appreciate your patience as we work through these challenges.

The drought has also affected some of our planned sod repairs and landscaping projects, slowing progress in those areas. We will continue to address these items as conditions allow.

On a positive note, we've recently made a couple of upgrades around the course. We've introduced a new flag system along with new flagsticks. By moving to a single-color flag system, we now have greater flexibility with pin placements, allowing us to use areas of the greens that were previously avoided due to being between color designations. This should provide more variety and an improved playing experience.

Thank you for your understanding and continued support as we manage through these conditions.

SWAT teams will consist of four players, counting one Gross score and one Net score per hole (these must be different balls). Each team will play Front 9, Back 9, and Overall matches against every other team in the field. Separate leaderboards will be kept for each segment, and the combined total of all three will determine final standings and payouts.

We are excited to introduce a new monthly game that will be hosted on the same day as Skins day each month.

There are many variations of SWAT formats—gross or net scoring, teams of two or four, counting one or multiple balls—which allows clubs to tailor the competition to their membership. Wildwood Green will use the same format as our member-member for our monthly SWAT games (Count 1 Net & 1 Gross). Monthly SWATs will be individual sign-ups and teams will be made via Golf Genius.

Handicap Allowance: 100%

Format SWAT: Count 1 Net and 1 Gross (cant be the same ball)

4. When selecting your tees, simply type the color (Blue, White, Gold, Green, Red/Green, or Red). Please avoid using abbreviations or typing things like “Mens blue tees” or “Blue Tees.”
5. Once you have registered, Hit Next, and then select your name. 6. After you have selected your name you will see the rounds you are able to sign up for.

Special Note: if you do this in the phone, all information will populate in the middle of the screen. If you sign up on your computer you will see the round sign-ups populate on the left side of the screen.



MGA is back on May 6th! Every Wednesday at 5:00 PM

The Men's Golf Association League kicks off Wednesday, May 6th at 5:00 PM. The league is open to male members of the club with an established GHIN handicap. Signups will need to be made weekly and by 2:00 PM two days prior to play. At 2:00 PM each Monday we will cut off signups and create the pairings for Wednesday evening.

Different formats will be played each week and the pairings will be made by the golf shop. Throughout the season you will earn points based on your finishes and at the end of the year the points winner will win a prize.

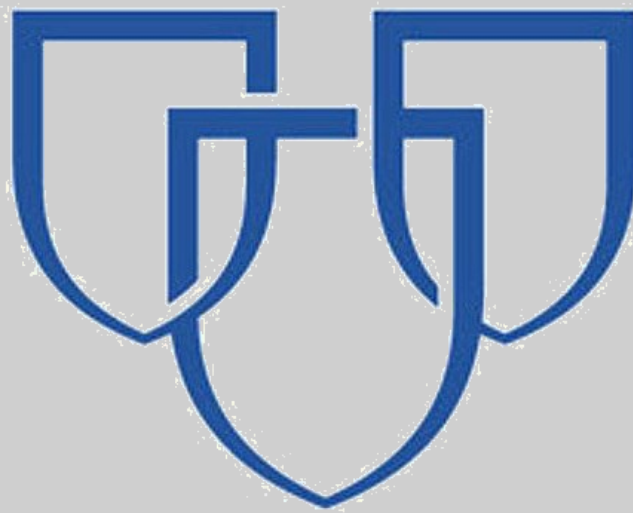
