Course Conditions Update

The last eight months have been challenging, to say the least. Our area has continued to experience unusually dry conditions, with the drought persisting throughout the spring and now into the early part of summer. These conditions have created a number of challenges for maintaining the golf course at the level our members and guests expect.

To help protect the health of the course, we have had to implement several measures that are not commonly used. One of the most difficult decisions was moving to cart-path-only restrictions due to the extremely dry turf conditions. We understand this can impact the golfing experience, but it was a necessary step to reduce stress on vulnerable areas of the course and preserve playing conditions for the long term.

Fortunately, we received some much-needed rainfall toward the end of June, allowing us to return to the 90-degree cart rule. While the recent rain has certainly helped, our irrigation reserves remain below where we would like them to be heading into the hottest months of the year. Summer weather can be unpredictable, and we are hopeful that additional thunderstorms and seasonal rainfall will continue to improve moisture levels and provide relief from the ongoing drought.

Because of our limited irrigation resources, we have made the decision to postpone the planned renovation of the 17th tee box until 2027. While we know many of you were looking forward to this improvement, we believe it is the most responsible course of action given current conditions. Our priority remains protecting the overall health and playability of the golf course.

We will, however, continue to address areas that require immediate attention. In the coming weeks, our team will be repairing several winter-kill areas with new sod to improve turf quality and appearance. These repairs will help strengthen affected sections and enhance overall playing conditions.

Greens aeration was completed in mid-June and went according to plan. Aeration is one of the most important cultural practices we perform throughout the year. By relieving soil compaction and creating channels for air, water, and nutrients to reach the root zone, aeration promotes healthier turf and stronger root development. Although the process can cause short-term disruption, the long-term benefits are essential to maintaining high-quality putting surfaces.

Looking ahead to July, we plan to use our AerWay equipment to aerate fairways and tees. This process will improve soil oxygen levels, increase water infiltration, and help turf better withstand summer stress. In addition, we will be applying a heavy topdressing to teeing areas to improve surface smoothness, encourage healthy turf growth, and support long-term playability.

We would like to sincerely thank all of our members and guests for their continued support, patience, and understanding throughout these challenging conditions. We greatly appreciate your comments, suggestions, and feedback. Your support allows us to continue making the best decisions for the course, and we remain committed to providing the best possible playing conditions despite the challenges presented by the weather.

We look forward to seeing everyone on the course and hope for a healthier, wetter second half of the summer.

SWAT teams will consist of four players, counting one Gross score and one Net score per hole (these must be different balls). Each team will play Front 9, Back 9, and Overall matches against every other team in the field. Separate leaderboards will be kept for each segment, and the combined total of all three will determine final standings and payouts.

Singles Without A Time Monthly Game

There are many variations of SWAT formats—gross or net scoring, teams of two or four, counting one or multiple balls—which allows clubs to tailor the competition to their membership. Wildwood Green will use the same format as our member-member for our monthly SWAT games (Count 1 Net & 1 Gross). Monthly SWATs will be individual sign-ups and teams will be made via Golf Genius.

Handicap Allowance: 100%

Format SWAT: Count 1 Net and 1 Gross (cant be the same ball)

Entry: \$20 CASH

Directions for registration:

Special Note: if you do this in the phone, all information will populate in the middle of the screen. If you sign up on your computer you will see the round sign-ups populate on the left side of the screen.



Every Wednesday around 5:00 PM

The Men's Golf Association League kicked off Wednesday, May 6th and runs each Wednesday through September. The league is open to male members of the club with an established GHIN handicap. Signups will need to be made weekly and by 2:00 PM two days prior to play. At 2:00 PM each Monday we will cut off signups and create the pairings for Wednesday evening.

Different formats will be played each week and the pairings will be made by the golf shop. Throughout the season you will earn points based on your finishes and at the end of the year the points winner will win a prize.

\$10 Weekly Entry Will Include:

- Entry will go towards skins and weekly competition
- Closest to the pin competition (prizes will vary)
- A chance to win cash skins at the year end event
- A chance to meet other male members of the club

Follow the steps below to Register for the league, then you can signup for each week one week prior to the play date. You can register for the league at any point in the season and there is no minimum or maximum to the amount of weeks you are required to play.
