Director of Golf Update

New YOC Restrictions

Effective June 1st, we will be implementing a few updates to how the Youth on Course (YOC) program operates at Wildwood Green.

First and foremost, Youth on Course is a wonderful program and something we are proud to support. Youth on Course is a national initiative that provides juniors with access to play golf at a reduced rate, helping grow the game by making it more accessible to young players.

Junior golf means a great deal to us, and introducing young players to the game is important for the long-term health of golf and the DNA of Wildwood Green.

At the same time, as many of you can understand, having too many children and teens on the golf course at discounted rates can present challenges for our staff, for members, and for the overall operation of the Club. As with anything, it's about finding the right balance.

At Wildwood Green, our membership, your experience, and the level of service you receive will always remain our top priority.

What's Changing:

- YOC play will be limited to 12:00 PM – 5:00 PM all 7 days a week
- Booking window will be reduced to 1 day in advance
- All YOC tee times must be booked through the official YOC portal, no phone call bookings

(Previously, YOC participants had access to a 3-day booking window for any tee times not booked already and with broader playing times permitted)

What This Means for You

These adjustments are aimed at improving the overall on-course experience, particularly during the later parts of the day, while maintaining the standard we expect throughout all hours of play.

We expect these adjustments will:

- Create better availability later in the day
- Improve overall pace and consistency of play
- Provide a more relaxed, enjoyable atmosphere for your round will have out₃ on the course.

What Is Not Changing

At this time, there are no changes to our regular public guests who are not part of Youth on Course.

- Public booking window remains 3 days in advance
- Public access remains Monday–Thursday anytime and afternoons only Friday–Sunday

We believe these changes strike the right balance, continuing to support junior golf while ensuring we are delivering the best possible experience for our membership. With anything, there will be an adjustment period as our YOC golfers who've played countless rounds here begin understand our new restrictions and fall in line with what's required of them.

Wildwood Green Golf Academy & Operation 36

These changes do not impact the Wildwood Green Golf Academy or its junior programming.

While the Academy is primarily made up of lessons, clinics, and instructional programming on our practice facilities, we will continue to fully support the Operation 36 play dates organized by Jimmy Hamilton.

These events typically take place one weekend evening per month and are scheduled directly through the golf shop by Jimmy Hamilton, our Director of Instruction. They will continue as they currently operate.

We appreciate your support and look forward to the positive impact these adjustments

New High School Structure

In addition to the Youth on Course updates, a similar operational approach will continue with our returning high school programs beginning this fall and moving forward.

Wildwood Green has proudly supported local high school golf programs for many years, and we fully intend to continue those relationships. Several of these programs include children of members, as well as faculty and staff who are part of the Wildwood Green family. Junior and high school golf remain an important part of the future of the game and something we value greatly.

At the same time, many of the limitations and scheduling structures surrounding high school golf that members have seen implemented over the past several years will continue to expand as the Club grows busier and demand for tee times and practice facilities continues to increase.

In recent years, Wildwood Green has already reduced the number of school usage days, limited facility access windows, restricted weekend usage, and implemented more structured scheduling procedures surrounding practices and matches. Additional refinements moving forward will continue focusing on limiting facility congestion, improving pace of play, protecting member access, and creating a more consistent daily operation for both members and guests.

Our goal is not to eliminate high school golf at Wildwood Green, but rather to ensure these programs can continue operating successfully in a way that remains sustainable for the Club long term while continuing to prioritize the membership experience.

New on Course Improvements

Another improvement members will begin seeing around the property in the coming months is the addition of new trash cans and divot mix containers throughout the golf course, funded through proceeds generated by the 50/50 fund.

The new trash cans will provide a cleaner, more polished appearance around the property compared to the current cylindrical cage-style containers, while the new divot mix stations will create a more consistent and user-friendly experience in areas where divot mix is needed.

In addition to improving functionality and ease of use, both upgrades are aimed at continuing to elevate the overall look and presentation of the golf course and daily member experience. The current sand bottle setup on many tee boxes has served its purpose over the years, but we believe these new stations will provide a much more attractive and professional long-term solution for the Club.

We appreciate everyone who participates in and supports the 50/50 fund, as projects like these are made possible directly through that continued support.

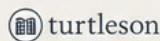

Course Conditions Update

We're finally starting to see some warmer weather this spring, although the dry conditions continue to be a major concern. Because of the ongoing drought, we've made the difficult decision to postpone any projects planned for 2026 until we receive significant rainfall and improved pond levels. Right now, our primary focus is preserving turf health and managing our available irrigation water as responsibly as possible.

With aerification scheduled for June, conserving water has become even more important. We've adjusted our watering schedules and modified how irrigation is being delivered throughout the course. Our greens remain the top priority, and the upcoming summer aerification will play an important role in helping them recover and remain healthy during the stressful summer months. Aerification reduces soil compaction and improves the movement of water, oxygen, and nutrients into the root zone, all of which are critical for strong turf growth.

In addition to the greens, we will also be aerating tees and fairways in an effort to continue improving overall turf quality across the course. While conditions have been challenging, our team remains focused on maintaining the best playing surfaces possible with the resources available.

We have experienced some winter kill on the number two fairway, along with a few smaller areas around the course. Recovery efforts are ongoing, and we are hopeful that summer temperatures combined with much-needed rainfall will help these areas continue to improve in the coming weeks.

As many golfers know, irrigation can help sustain turf during dry periods, but there is simply no substitute for natural rainfall. We are all hoping for steady summer storms to restore our irrigation ponds to healthy levels and provide some long-term relief from the drought conditions.

SWAT teams will consist of four players, counting one Gross score and one Net score per hole (these must be different balls). Each team will play Front 9, Back 9, and Overall matches against every other team in the field. Separate leaderboards will be kept for each segment, and the combined total of all three will determine final standings and payouts.

We are excited to introduce a new monthly game that will be hosted on the same day as Skins day each month.

There are many variations of SWAT formats—gross or net scoring, teams of two or four, counting one or multiple balls—which allows clubs to tailor the competition to their membership. Wildwood Green will use the same format as our member-member for our monthly SWAT games (Count 1 Net & 1 Gross). Monthly SWATs will be individual sign-ups and teams will be made via Golf Genius.

Handicap Allowance: 100%

Format SWAT: Count 1 Net and 1 Gross (cant be the same ball)

Entry: \$20 CASH

Directions for registration:

1. Click [HERE](#) and hit the “New Registration” button.
2. Search for your name in the search bar.
3. If you cannot find your name, please reach out to drew@wildwoodgreen.com for assistance.
4. When selecting your tees, simply type the color (Blue, White, Gold, Green, Red/Green, or Red). Please avoid using abbreviations or typing things like “Mens blue tees” or “Blue Tees.”
5. Once you have registered, Hit Next, and then select your name. 6. After you have selected your name you will see the rounds you are able to sign up for.

Special Note: if you do this in the phone, all information will populate in the middle of the screen. If you sign up on your computer you will see the round sign-ups populate on the left side of the screen.



Every Wednesday at 5:00 PM

The Men's Golf Association League kicks off Wednesday, May 6th at 5:00 PM. The league is open to male members of the club with an established GHIN handicap. Signups will need to be made weekly and by 2:00 PM two days prior to play. At 2:00 PM each Monday we will cut off signups and create the pairings for Wednesday evening.

Different formats will be played each week and the pairings will be made by the golf shop. Throughout the season you will earn points based on your finishes and at the end of the year the points winner will win a prize.

\$10 Weekly Entry Will Include:

- Entry will go towards skins and weekly competition
- Closest to the pin competition (prizes will vary)
- A chance to win cash skins at the year end event
- A chance to meet other male members of the club

For example, if your course handicap is 9 you will have 79 shots. Once you have hit your 79th shot, where ever your ball lies you will plant your flag. If you shoot 74 thru 18 you will continue on to hole 1 and play through till you have used your last 5 shots.

- Open to all players and all tee times till 2:30pm

- You must have a current GHIN handicap
- You must have your round attested by at least one other player.

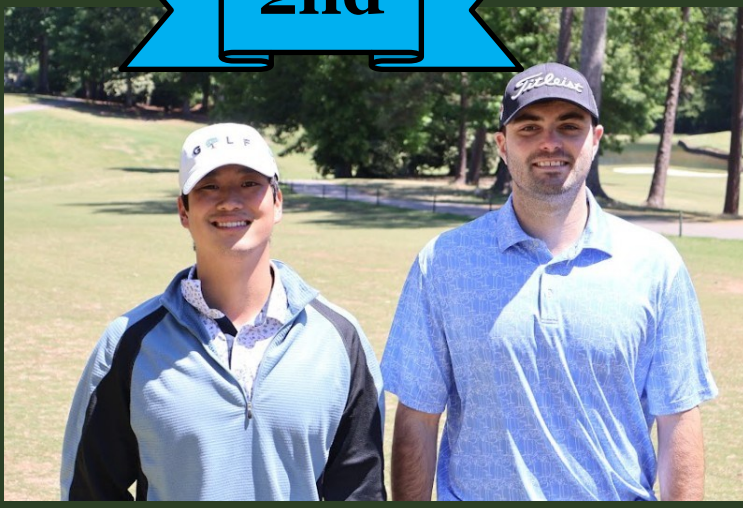
