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Director of Golf Update

The Wildwood Green Difference

The value of a golf membership should not be measured only by what a member pays. It should be measured the value of what is received in return, including the quality of the golf course, greater access to tee times, more opportunities to play and compete, exceptional personal and professional service, and the experience of belonging to a club where people know your name and members feel a part of a community. Wildwood Green is a semi-private golf club, but our membership remains the foundation of everything we do. Our goal is to provide an excellent experience with outstanding service while continuing to offer one of the best membership values in the Triangle.

Exceptional Value

Wildwood Green is recognized among the top 40 courses you can play in North Carolina. Our course can challenge accomplished players while remaining enjoyable for golfers of all abilities. Membership also includes a large calendar of leagues, tournaments, instruction and player development opportunities throughout the year. Ownership has remained committed to keeping membership pricing stable and measured while continuing to reinvest in the course, facilities and staff. Adjustments will sometimes be necessary as costs rise, but our goal is to avoid dramatic changes and continue providing value well beyond the cost of membership.

Member access is another major part of that value. Wildwood members can reserve tee times 15 days in advance beginning at 6:00 a.m. and receive protected access on Friday, Saturday and Sunday mornings. Those are incredibly beneficial advantages at a golf course experiencing the level of demand we currently see. Even when the tee sheet is full, our member waitlist has successfully accommodated approximately 95% of requests this calendar year. Members may not always receive the exact time originally requested, but communication and flexibility give us a very strong chance of finding an opportunity to play.

If the tee sheet is full, please continue to contact us and add your name to the waitlist. We are here to help, but we can only help with the situations we know about. Wildwood Green is as busy as it has ever been, and that demand is one of the clearest signs of the value found here. A busy golf club can experience some of the same pressures as a popular restaurant on a full night. Our responsibility is to improve staffing, preparation and service so we can handle that demand while protecting the access and benefits that come with membership.

Constant Improvement

Ownership and myself both believe that Wildwood Green should never become satisfied or stop looking for ways to improve. We are proud of the Club's success, but we cannot allow that success to make us comfortable. Improvement can mean better course conditions, physical additions around the property, stronger operating procedures, improved communication or better service. Not every improvement will be a major construction project. Each one, regardless of size, should make Wildwood Green a better golf club and a better membership value.

Rick Durham and the maintenance team continue to give constant attention to course conditions while managing weather, heavy traffic and the daily demands placed on the golf course. Their work begins long before the first tee time and often continues after the final group has finished. The condition of the course is not the result of one project or one season. It comes from consistent work and a commitment to making the property better every day. That daily effort remains one of the most important parts of the Wildwood Green experience.

This year, we have continued improving the appearance, convenience and functionality of the Club. We introduced our new flag presentation, added alignment sticks to the driving range, installed more than 30 divot mix containers and placed new, more visually appealing trash cans throughout the course. These are some of the most visible additions, but they represent only part of the work being done. Other improvements have included better tee sheet management, more detailed pace monitoring, stronger golfer communication, staff scheduling and service. We still have many projects planned and have no intention of stopping our improvements any time soon.

My job each day consist of a wide variety of objectives all focused at one simple goal. I want to find a way to make Wildwood Green 1% better as a golf club, as an operation and as a membership value. One percent may not sound like much on a single day, but small improvements add up when they are made consistently. Some will be immediately noticeable, while others will improve the way we operate behind the scenes. All of them will have the same purpose of continuing to move Wildwood Green forward.



Pace of Play: Measurable Progress

Our pace of play is one of the clearest examples of this continued improvement. Our average pace has improved each month, with our yearly average currently running at 4 hours and 9 minutes. That is seven minutes faster than Wildwood Green's USGA Pace Rating of 4 hours and 16 minutes. The USGA rating also does not include time spent at the turn, making our complete round average even more encouraging. This is especially notable when considering the number of golfers moving through Wildwood Green each day.

A day with 250 players typically means roughly 60 to 70 groups moving through one 18-hole golf course across more than 10 hours of tee times. Research from the USGA and The R&A confirms what we see every day, the number of groups on a course and the spacing between them have a major effect on pace. The R&A recommends considering intervals of 11 or 12 minutes when primarily scheduling foursomes. Moving Wildwood to 12-minute intervals might produce a modest improvement in pace, but it would eliminate approximately 12 tee times and reduce daily access by as many as 48 golfers. Our 10-minute intervals allow us to maintain a strong pace while providing substantially more opportunities for our members to play.

Despite the amount of play we accommodate, our 4:09 yearly average compares favorably with the 4:17 average full round cited in USGA pace research, as well as the longer round times commonly seen at other high-volume facilities managing similarly full tee sheets. USGA research also shows how quickly small delays can build throughout a busy day. In one study, a difference of only 90 seconds between the starting interval and the rate groups moved through the course added 90 minutes to the round time by the 60th group. When we have 60 to 70 groups moving through Wildwood Green, protecting the space between those groups becomes extremely important. Maintaining our current average is something we are proud of and reflects the work being done by both our staff and golfers.

These same principles are part of the reason our starters may ask a group to allow the group ahead to reach the first green before beginning its round. The request is not intended to create an unnecessary delay. It protects the spacing between groups and gives everyone a better opportunity to move through the course without unnecessary waiting. Arriving early and being ready to play is important, but being ready does not always mean teeing off early. Starting groups ahead of schedule can remove the spacing built into the tee sheet and create delays for groups later in the day.

Pace of play is not controlled by one ranger, one starter or one fast group. It depends on proper spacing from the first tee, ready golf, awareness of the group ahead, accurate information and staff members willing to step in when a group falls out of position. Maintaining a 4:09 average with the amount of play Wildwood experiences takes a consistent system and cooperation between staff and golfers. Better use of our GPS pace tracking system, starter communication, a more active ranger presence and greater attention from the Golf Shop have all contributed to the improvement. The numbers show that progress is being made, and our job is to keep it going.

Outstanding Service and a Sense of Belonging

A quality golf course and facility is only one part of a great club. The service provided before, during and after a round is just as important. Our carts equipped with GPS, bag drop, club cleaning, courtesy rides, starter service, on-course ranger and beverage cart are all intended to make a day at Wildwood Green different from an ordinary round of golf. These services require more than employees simply completing assigned tasks. They require people who care about making members feel welcomed, recognized and appreciated.

Our goal is to build a high-quality staff that works together to provide an excellent experience with outstanding service. Finding people willing to work is not always difficult, but finding the right people for seasonal and part-time service positions can be much more challenging. Summer generally provides us with ample staffing and availability. As schools resume and we move into the fall, many of our part-time employees have fewer hours available. Services such as bag drop, club cleaning, courtesy rides and the beverage cart can become harder to staff as consistently, but that challenge does not change our standard.

We remain committed to recruiting, training and retaining the right employees while adjusting schedules to provide these services as consistently as possible. Many members may receive one or two performance reviews each year, or perhaps none at all. My staff and I receive approximately 250 to 300 performance reviews every day because every person who visits Wildwood forms an opinion about the course, the operation and the service provided by our team. We understand and welcome that daily accountability. It pushes us to listen, improve and maintain a high standard.

That is also why accessibility matters. Please continue to come speak with me and allow me to listen to whatever you may have to say, whether it is positive or critical. We cannot correct a problem, explain a situation or recognize an employee unless we know about it. When you see one of our part-time employees working hard and providing outstanding service, please also consider letting that person know you appreciate them. A kind word can mean a great deal, particularly to a young employee, and helps reinforce the service culture we are working to build.



Continued Success

The continued success of Wildwood Green is not based on one person, one department or one improvement. It begins with ownership continuing to believe in the Club, support our staff and give us the opportunity to keep moving Wildwood Green forward. That support extends throughout the operation, including Rick Durham and the maintenance team, Sunshine Stogner and the food and beverage team, the Golf Shop staff, our instructional team and our outside service staff. Every department has a different responsibility, but we are all working toward the same goal. That goal is to provide an excellent experience with outstanding service.

Our membership is also a major part of that success. Your continued support, participation and feedback allow us to invest in the golf course, develop our staff and improve the overall experience. Wildwood Green succeeds when ownership, management, every department and the membership work together. Our members are a major reason I have been able to succeed here, and I would not be doing my job to the best of my ability if I were not accessible to each of you. We do not take your support or the responsibility that comes with it for granted.

I am proud to be the Director of Golf and Head Golf Professional at Wildwood Green. I am proud of our staff, proud of what the Club has accomplished and excited about what is still ahead. What makes Wildwood Green special is not one individual benefit or amenity, but the combination of a top 40 golf course, valuable member access, stable pricing, continued improvements, personal service and a community where members are known. That combination is increasingly difficult to find. Thank you all for the pride you take in being a Wildwood Green member and for being such an important part of the community we continue to build here.

Course Conditions Update

After receiving less than two inches of rain combined during April, May, and June, July brought a dramatic change with nearly 15 inches of rainfall. We went from an extended dry stretch to one of the wettest months we've experienced in years. To say it has been challenging would be an understatement.

In fact, this July was the second wettest on record, while also being the hottest July on record. Those conditions created a perfect storm for golf course maintenance. Heavy rain made it difficult to keep equipment on the course, while the heat caused the turf to grow at an incredible rate whenever conditions allowed us to mow.

As many of you noticed, mowing fell behind for about a week as we waited for the course to dry enough to safely operate equipment. Catching up has been a constant challenge, but thanks to the hard work and dedication of our maintenance team, we finally feel like we have things back under control. We appreciate your patience and understanding while we worked through these unusual weather conditions.

On the improvement side, we're pleased to report that sod has been installed on No. 2 fairway, as well as several collars and the approach on No. 11. These areas have already made a noticeable improvement, and we know there are still a few more spots that need attention. Finding the time to complete those projects has been difficult with the constant rain and the priority of keeping the course playable, but they remain on our schedule as conditions allow.

We're hopeful that August will bring more typical weather so we can continue catching up on routine maintenance and complete additional improvement projects throughout the course. Our goal, as always, is to provide the best possible playing conditions, and we appreciate your continued support as we work through this challenging season.

SWAT teams will consist of four players, counting one Gross score and one Net score per hole (these must be different balls). Each team will play Front 9, Back 9, and Overall matches against every other team in the field. Separate leaderboards will be kept for each segment, and the combined total of all three will determine final standings and payouts.

We are excited to introduce a new monthly game that will be hosted on the same day as Skins day each month.

There are many variations of SWAT formats—gross or net scoring, teams of two or four, counting one or multiple balls—which allows clubs to tailor the competition to their membership. Wildwood Green will use the same format as our member-member for our monthly SWAT games (Count 1 Net & 1 Gross). Monthly SWATs will be individual sign-ups and teams will be made via Golf Genius.

Handicap Allowance: 100%

Format SWAT: Count 1 Net and 1 Gross (cant be the same ball)

Entry: \$20 CASH

Directions for registration:

1. Click [HERE](#) and hit the “New Registration” button.
2. Search for your name in the search bar.
3. If you cannot find your name, please reach out to drew@wildwoodgreen.com for assistance.
4. When selecting your tees, simply type the color (Blue, White, Gold, Green, Red/Green, or Red). Please avoid using abbreviations or typing things like “Mens blue tees” or “Blue Tees.”
5. Once you have registered, Hit Next, and then select your name. 6. After you have selected your name you will see the rounds you are able to sign up for.

Special Note: if you do this in the phone, all information will populate in the middle of the screen. If you sign up on your computer you will see the round sign-ups populate on the left side of the screen.



Every Wednesday at 5:00 PM

Signups will need to be made weekly and by 2:00 PM two days prior to play. At 2:00 PM each Monday we will cut off signups and create the pairings for Wednesday evening.

Congratulations to all of our Interclub teams that have advanced to the playoffs!

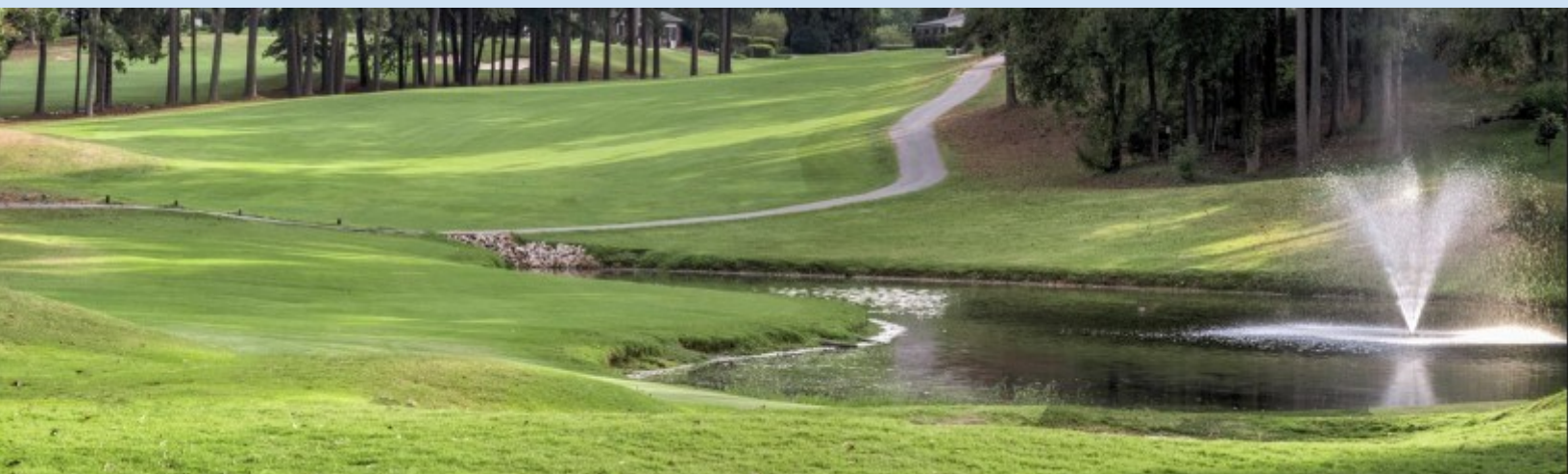

Emergency Response

If an Emergency Happens on the Course

We hope an emergency never occurs at Wildwood Green, but a golf course creates unique challenges when one does. An incident may happen several holes away from the clubhouse with no staff member immediately nearby. Knowing who to call and providing an accurate location can save valuable time.

If an emergency occurs, stay with the affected individual, especially if they are unresponsive, and call 911 immediately. If you are playing in a threesome or foursome, one player should remain with the individual and call 911 while another calls the Golf Shop at 919-846-8376. Provide the hole number, the person's condition and the closest landmark you can identify. If you are alone, remain with the individual, place 911 on speaker and call the Golf Shop immediately afterward.

Wildwood Green has a detailed emergency response procedure for every area of the course. We have an AED, first aid kits, a tourniquet, splint and choking response device on property. Our primary emergency equipment is stored near the Golf Shop, with an additional first aid kit located at the maintenance barn. Once the Golf Shop receives the call, one of our 11 AHA certified staff members will immediately head toward the incident with the proper equipment. Another staff member will contact 911, provide the best access location for the quickest response and then meet and escort EMS to the patient.

According to the American Heart Association, immediate CPR can double or triple a person's chance of surviving cardiac arrest. The chance of survival can decrease by approximately 7% to 10% for every minute that a normal heartbeat is not restored. In a large study, survival was 66.5% when an AED shock was delivered before EMS arrived, compared with 43% when the first shock came from EMS.

This is why those first two calls matter. Stay with the individual, call 911, call the Golf Shop and follow the dispatcher's directions until trained help arrives.
