As summer begins to wind down, September brings some of the best golfing weather of the year and plenty to celebrate around Wildwood Green.

Wildwood Roots on Golf's Biggest Stages

Congratulations to Michael La Sasso on earning his first professional LIV Golf victory in Indianapolis. Michael grew up as a member at Wildwood Green and spent countless hours playing and practicing here. It has been exciting to watch his career develop, and we are proud to see someone with such strong Wildwood roots succeed at the professional level.

We would also like to congratulate Doc Redman on securing his PGA TOUR card for the 2027 season. Doc became the first player to earn TOURBound status during the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour season after recording two victories and two additional top-10 finishes.

Long before winning the 2017 U.S. Amateur or competing professionally, Doc was a regular at Wildwood Green. He developed his game here with the support of our members and teaching professionals while competing alongside many of the outstanding junior players who came through Wildwood during that time.

Congratulations are also in order for Ryan Gerard, who finished 17th on the season-long FedExCup points list and qualified for the TOUR Championship at East Lake where he finished solo 3rd.

Ryan's connection to Wildwood Green goes back nearly his entire life. His family moved into a home beside the 15th hole when he was around five years old. He spent countless hours practicing here, including short-game sessions using hula hoops and "impossible chipping contests" with players such as Doc Redman and Carter Jenkins.

In 2016, Doc and Ryan both competed in the prestigious Junior Invitational at Sage Valley and were believed to be the first two players from the same public-access golf course to compete in the event together.

Introducing the Watson Cup

That history also makes this year's renaming of the WWG Ryder Cup especially meaningful. Moving forward, the event will be known as the Watson Cup in memory of Roger Watson.

Roger was much more than Wildwood Green's longtime owner. He was one of the most accomplished PGA professionals in North Carolina golf history. Roger won the National PGA Club Professional Championship in 1974, defeating the legendary Sam Snead in a playoff at Pinehurst No. 2, and successfully defended his title in 1975. He also won the Carolinas PGA Championship in 1975 and 1976 and represented the United States in the PGA Cup in both of those years.

Roger helped establish the culture of competitive golf, junior development and welcoming public access that continues to define Wildwood Green today. Naming one of our premier team competitions the Watson Cup is a fitting way to honor his legacy.

Wildwood Continues to Grow

The tremendous demand golf experienced during the early COVID years has now settled into a more sustainable pattern, but the game remains considerably stronger than it was before the pandemic. Nationally, more than 500 million rounds have been played in each of the past six years, and 2025 produced another all-time record.

Wildwood Green has followed a similar path. We finished 2025 with 50,668 rounds, an increase of 2.1% over 2024. Through July of this year, we hosted 29,176 rounds, an additional increase of approximately 0.5%.

More importantly, member rounds are up approximately 3% this year, while non-member rounds have declined approximately 3%. Members now account for approximately 58% of all play. These numbers show that Wildwood remains a growing and highly utilized facility, with an increasing percentage of our available golf being enjoyed by members.

Even with the continued demand, our average pace of play remains 4 hours and 9 minutes—seven minutes better than our

Youth On Course and High-School Golf

Beginning June 1, we adjusted our Youth On Course availability to better protect high-demand tee times for members. Youth On Course reservations now have a one-day booking window and are available only between 12:00 and 5:00 p.m. each day.

The early results suggest that the changes are creating a better balance. Youth On Course rounds during June and July declined 8.7% compared with the same period last year. During those two months, member play was slightly higher, and members' share of total play increased from 52.3% to 57%.

Our goal was never to move away from junior golf. As the accomplishments of Michael, Doc, Ryan and many others demonstrate, junior development is an important part of Wildwood Green's identity. Our goal is to continue offering meaningful and affordable junior access while protecting the most in-demand tee times and improving the overall member experience.

As the fall high-school season begins, we have also placed additional limits on school-team access. Each school receives one designated on-course day and one practice-facility day per week, Monday through Thursday only. School practices, matches and team-facility use are not permitted Friday through Sunday.

On-course practices are limited to two tee times. Only one school may receive on-course access each day, and only one school may receive practice-facility access each day. Matches must be submitted at least 16 days in advance and approved by the Director of Golf. All participating players must also be enrolled in Youth On Course.

These guidelines allow us to continue supporting local junior and high-school golf while limiting its effect on member tee-time availability and practice-facility access.

Fall Hours and Maintenance

Effective August 30, twilight begins at 4:00 p.m., and the first tee time is 7:30 a.m. The first tee time will move to 8:00 a.m. beginning October 4.

Monday maintenance days will continue through the end of October. These delayed openings provide Rick and the maintenance team with the uninterrupted time needed to complete topdressing, course preparation and other important seasonal work.

Because Labor Day falls on Monday, our regular maintenance work will take place on Tuesday, September 8. The first tee time that day will be at 12:00 p.m. We appreciate everyone's patience and cooperation.

2027 Prepayment Discounts

The 10% discount for prepaying 2027 membership fees ended August 31. Members who missed the original deadline may still receive a 7% discount by prepaying during September.

From October through December, a 5% prepayment discount will be available. Please contact the Golf Shop or club office with any questions regarding the 2027 prepayment program.

Staff Recognition

Drew continues to do an outstanding job organizing and improving our member-event program. From developing formats and managing registration to handling all the details behind the scenes, his work has helped us build an excellent event calendar.

Nick has also done an excellent job managing the Golf Shop, maintaining a strong merchandise selection and making sure our members and guests receive outstanding service.

Anyone who has worked with me knows I tend to set the bar pretty high, Drew and Nick might replace "pretty high" with "unreasonably high", but both continue to clear it.

Thank you to Drew, Nick and the rest of our staff for their continued hard work. Thank you as well to our members for another busy summer and for everything you do to make Wildwood Green a special

Course Conditions Update

The hot summer continues. We have experienced a few hints of fall here and there, but overall, the weather has remained predominantly hot and dry.

The good news is that the wetter-than-normal July helped set us up well for August. Hopefully, we will receive a little more rain soon and enjoy more of the cooler fall weather.

We will continue topdressing the greens as long as the warm weather persists. We are still catching up from the wet conditions in July, which delayed some of our scheduled applications. In early August, this became evident as we began to see some scalping in areas of the greens. After multiple topdressing applications, we have been able to get this under control.

As fall approaches, we will begin preparing for our fall pre-emergent and fertilizer applications. Both treatments help strengthen the turf as we move into winter, and late summer to early fall is the ideal time to apply them.

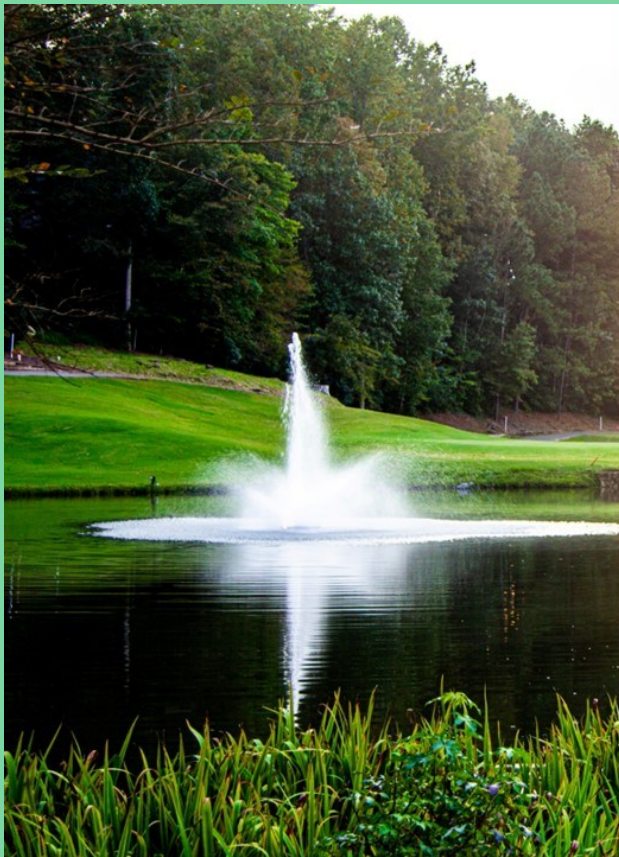

SWAT teams will consist of four players, counting one Gross score and one Net score per hole (these must be different balls). Each team will play Front 9, Back 9, and Overall matches against every other team in the field. Separate leaderboards will be kept for each segment, and the combined total of all three will determine final standings and payouts.

We are excited to introduce a new monthly game that will be hosted on the same day as Skins day each month.

There are many variations of SWAT formats—gross or net scoring, teams of two or four, counting one or multiple balls—which allows clubs to tailor the competition to their membership. Wildwood Green will use the same format as our member-member for our monthly SWAT games (Count 1 Net & 1 Gross). Monthly SWATs will be individual sign-ups and teams will be made via Golf Genius.
